

## Confidentiality and other principles relating to the contribution of information to and the access of information from the National Wildlife Health Database

- 1. These principles are intended to apply to both the contribution to and accessing of information (other than that already in the public domain) from the National Wildlife Health Database ("the Database") held and maintained by the Department of Conservation ("DOC"):
- 2. This document is intended to record the agreement of both contributors and those accessing the Database with these principles and the terms for use. Those signing this document will become Registered Users.
- 3. Information made available through the Database is provided on the basis that it may assist in the study and control of diseases in native species, and so that researchers and managers can share the information for that purpose.
- 4. Ownership of the information for any other purpose remains with the individual or organisation reporting or contributing this information i.e. the original source of the information.
- 5. Unless, it is indicated to the contrary in the Project Information for National Wildlife Health Database Submission Form, such information may be passed on to other relevant staff within a person's organisation or related organisations, provided
  - (a) the source of information is cited, and
  - (b) recipients of the information are advised that it is confidential information that is intended for use only with respect to the control of diseases of native species and for their management;
     and
  - (c) the following disclaimer is attached to the information:
    - "The following information is CONFIDENTIAL and is intended for use only with respect to the control of diseases of native species and their management".
- 6. In particular, this information should not be given to the media or used in academic or other publications without the specific and written approval of the original source (owner) of this information.
- 7. People contributing information to the Database must:
- a. exercise care in providing information to ensure that it is accurate to the best of their knowledge; and
- b. use the Project Information Form for National Wildlife Health Database.
