

The boundary of the reserve has changed slightly, as shown on the map above. The old boundary, marked in "red" is replaced by the "blue" boundary.

Offence penalties carry up to 3 months imprisonment or a \$250,000 fine, or both. Vehicles, vessels and equipment may be seized.

## Tāwharanui Marine Reserve

Hauraki Gulf Marine Park

The Tāwharanui Marine Reserve was established in September 2011. The marine reserve replaces the Tawharanui Marine Park, which opened in July 1981. The new marine reserve will be administered by the Department of Conservation. People are welcome to dive, snorkel, swim and visit the reserve, however all marine life continues to be totally protected and fishing, netting, gathering shellfish or otherwise interfering with marine life is prohibited.
