

# How you can help Māui

### Fisherman?

- Don't use set nets where restrictions are not in place but dolphins may be found
- Stay with your net if you see
   dolphins, lift your net immediately

#### Boatie?

- Use a 'no wake' speed within 300 m of dolphins
- Don't swim with Māui dolphins or attempt to feed them

#### Cat lover?

 Don't dispose of cat litter or other animal faeces in toilets, drains or stormwater systems – this may spread Toxoplasmosis to Māui dolphins

## Everyone

- Recycle and don't litter –
   Māui may swallow rubbish or get entangled in it
- Support community groups and NGOs that help Māui dolphins
- Get involved in government decision-making – vote, write letters supporting Māui/marine conservation, stay informed, and submit on public consultations
