

Welcome to Peel Forest Campground

This is a family-friendly camp ground within Peel Forest Park Scenic Reserve. It is ideally sited for outdoor activities in the Rangitata valley. The camp is environmentally friendly with solar water-heating and a rubbish-recycling system.

Help keep this place special by following the camp rules;

Noise

Be mindful of other campers. Generators are not permitted after 10 pm.

Fire

No fires permitted. Gas cooking only.

Animals

No pets allowed.

Behaviour

Any unacceptable behaviour will result in you being asked to leave without a refund.

Safety

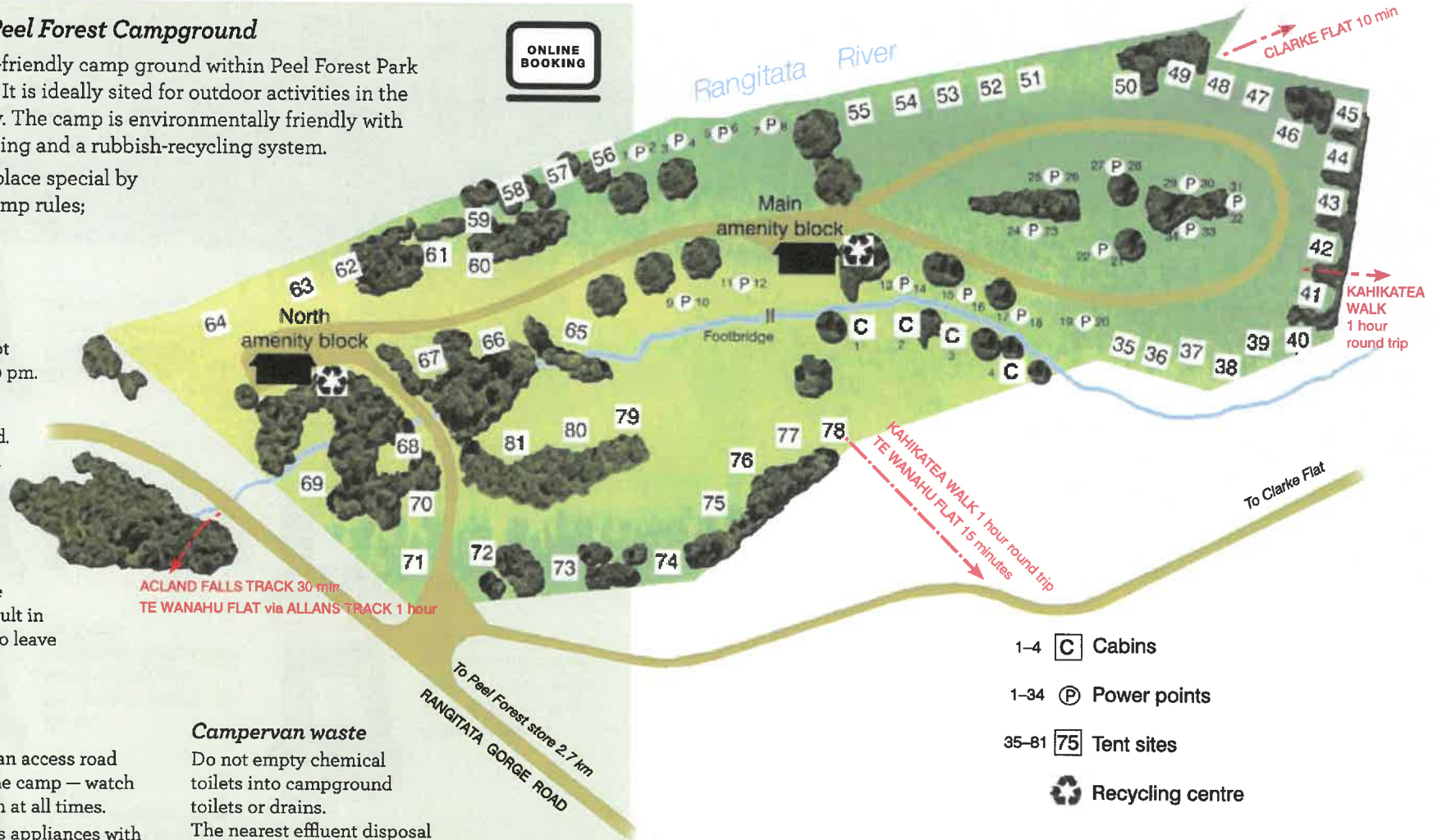
- A stream and an access road run through the camp – watch young children at all times.
- Always use gas appliances with care, ensuring a safe distance from any combustible material and with adequate ventilation.
- Speed limit 10 km/h – watch for children.
- Any vehicles using powered sites must have a current electrical warrant of fitness.
- Pitch your tent 1.5 m from your site boundary.

Campervan waste

Do not empty chemical toilets into campground toilets or drains. The nearest effluent disposal points for campervans are at Mt Somers and Geraldine.

Didymo

Check, Clean, Dry
Stop the spread of didymo and other freshwater pests. Remember to **Check, Clean, Dry** all items before entering, and when moving between, waterways.
