ABSTRACT

A directory of New Zealand research agencies and consultants with expertise in tikanga Māori and/or social science fields which relate to the conservation of natural and human resources is provided. It includes government departments, universities, museums, research institutes, companies and individual consultants and shows the research fields in which they have expertise.

INTRODUCTION

This directory was developed by the Information Unit of the Science and Research Division of the Department of Conservation as a supplement to the directory "Conservation Research Skills -Where to Find Them" compiled by Helen M. Adcock and W. Mary McEwen. It was compiled in response to a need for a more comprehensive listing of agencies with research skills in the social sciences and tikanga Māori. It is not intended that this directory replace any existing directories and/or databases held by other agencies (e.g. the Social Science Research Fund Committee Directory of Social Scientists, 1989). This directory is intended to assist those involved in the conservation of natural and historic resources and to identify and locate sources of expertise in the social sciences and tikanga Māori fields. A related publication, the Directory of New Zealand Market Survey and Research Organisations, 1984, provides a list of survey organisations which provide market research services on a contract basis.

A questionnaire was sent to a large number of research agencies and consultants to ascertain their research skills and knowledge. The data obtained were entered on a database, and were checked for accuracy by the agency concerned in April/May 1990. The information in this directory is believed to be correct as at the 1st of June 1990.

Additional agencies will be added to this directory, in future, as they come to hand. When the number of additional agencies and the number of alterations made to the existing agencies warrants it we will publish supplements. Readers can assist in this process by advising the author of corrections or additions which should be made, using the form at the back of this publication. The directory includes:

List I:	Keywords used to describe fields covered in the directory;
Index I:	The agencies included, arranged by government departments, universities, museums and research institutes, and companies and consultants;
Index II:	Research fields (keywords) showing the numbers of pages on which agencies with expertise in those fields are listed;
The Directory:	An alphabetical listing of all agencies and consultants.

The directory can be used to discover which agencies have expertise in a particular research field or to ascertain the research fields with which a particular agency is involved.

Further information about the social science and tikanga Māori research skills of a particular agency can be obtained from the agency itself using the address given, or from the Information Services Unit.
