National WARO permit

(Term up to five years: expires on 30 November 2014, non-notified, issued by Canterbury Conservancy)

North Island schedule:

- Deer carcass recovery (all species)
- Live deer capture (all species)
- Pig and goat carcass recovery
- Live pig and goat capture

South Island schedule:

- Deer carcass recovery (all species)
- Live deer capture (all species)
- Pig, goat, wallaby and chamois carcass recovery only

Heli-hunting concession permit

(Term to be advised, publicly notified)

- Nationally standard conditions, Site specific conditions

Tahr carcass recovery and live capture

(Permit, non-notified)

- Issued by Canterbury and/or West Coast
- Managed under the Tahr Control Plan, liaison required
- Nationally standard conditions
- Site-specific conditions

Live capture of chamois, pigs, goats, wallaby

(South Island only permit, non notified)

- Issued by local South Island Conservancy
- Nationally standard conditions
- Site-specific conditions
