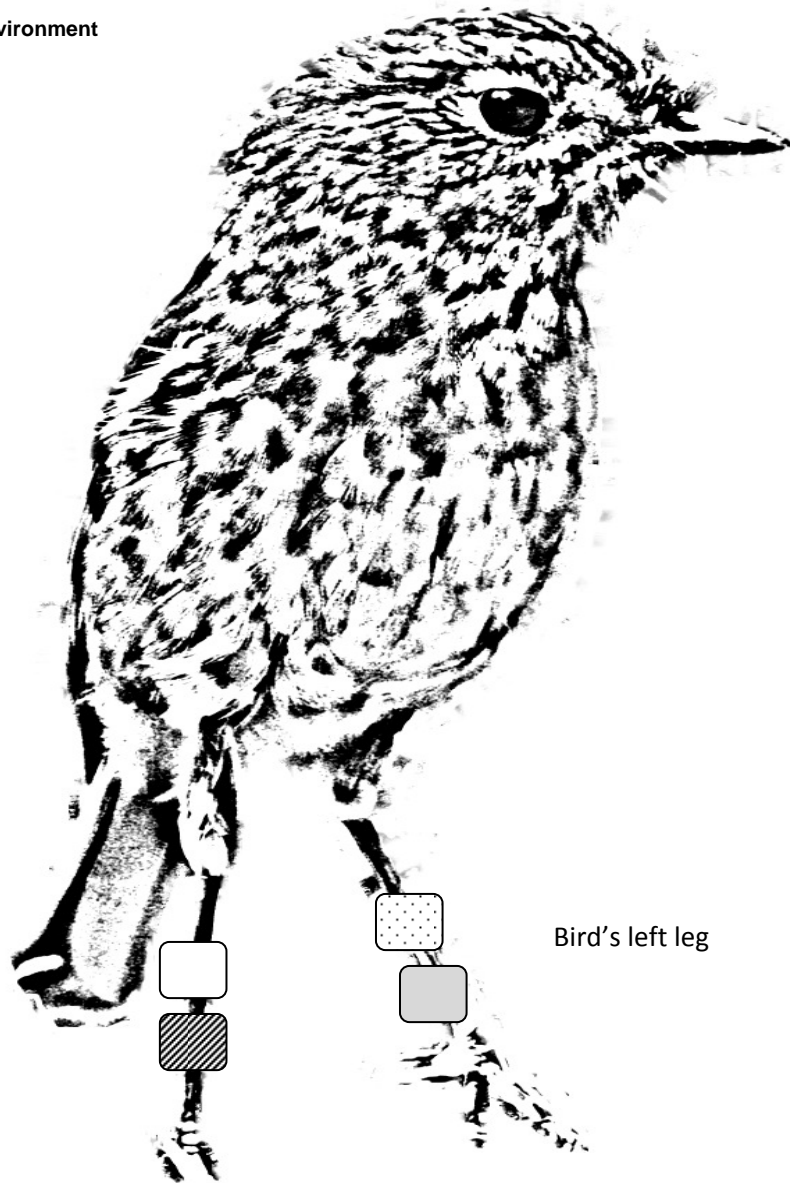

Every bird has one leg with a red colour band over a silver metal band. The other leg has one, two or three colour bands, which is it's unique ID. The band colours could be green, yellow, orange, white, blue, black or red.
