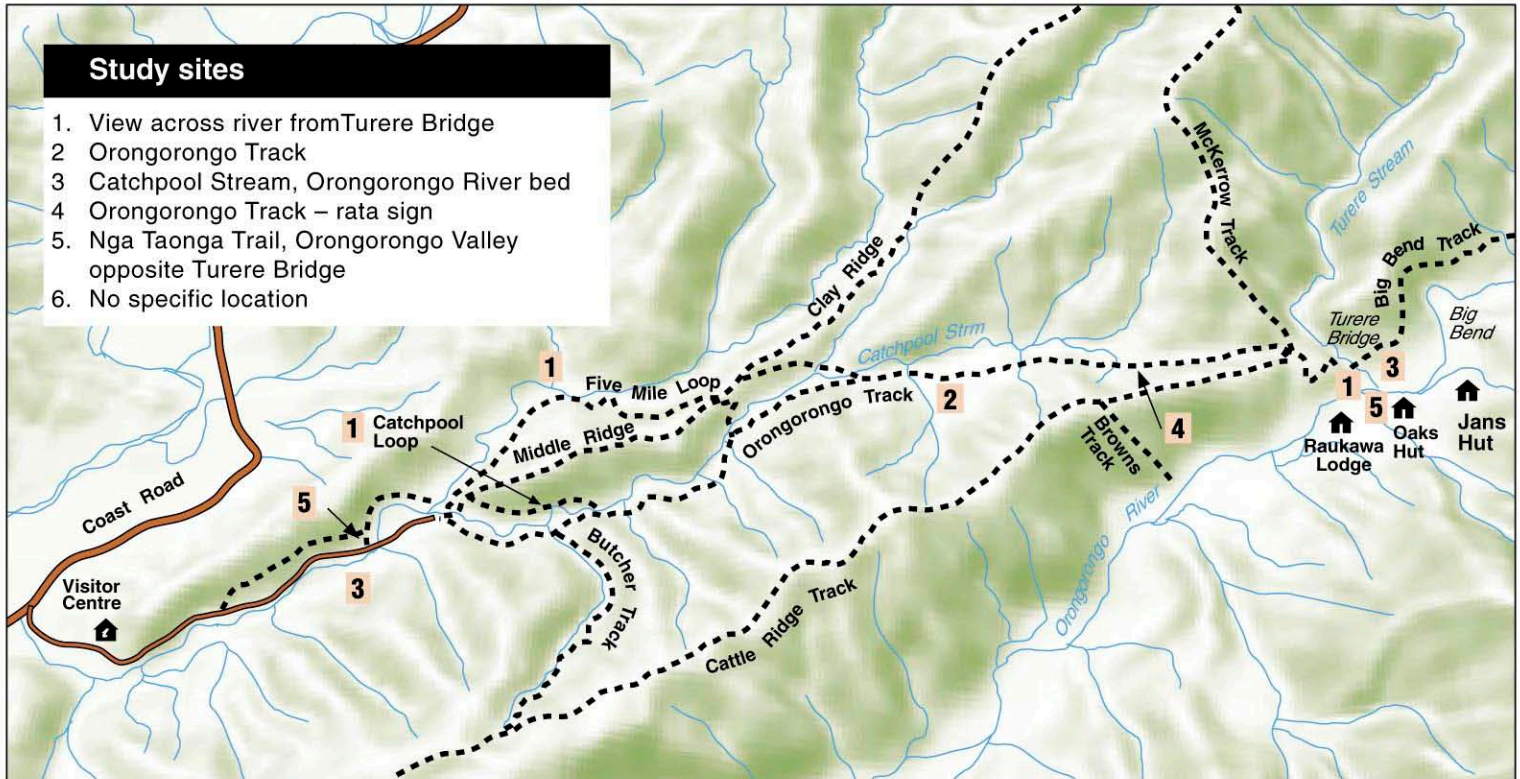


Orongorongo Valley activity cards

- Interpretation panels in order of appearance – Podocarp/hardwood forest, Epiphytes, Northern rata, Colonisation after disturbance, Forest recovery.
