

**ABEL TASMAN FORESHORE SCENIC RESERVE
AUTHORISATION OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES**

Pursuant to sections 42, 50 and 94 of the Reserves Act 1977, the Administration Committee, acting under delegation from the Minister of Conservation and the Director-General of Conservation, hereby gives express consent and declares that the following activities, for non-commercial purposes only, are authorised within the Abel Tasman Foreshore Scenic Reserve (but excluding that part of the scenic reserve which is within the Tonga Island Marine Reserve), subject to any stated conditions, until further notice.

The activities and conditions are:

- (i) The use of traps, nets or fishing lines;
- (ii) The taking of fish, including shellfish;
- (iii) The taking of seaweed, provided that it is collected by hand, and is not attached to the seabed or to a rock; and
- (iv) The taking of driftwood, provided that it is limited to an amount that can be personally carried, and a chainsaw, axe or other like machinery or implement is not used.
