Tramping in Egmont National Park

Egmont National Park offers a wide range of opportunities to those wanting to experience the outdoors - from short walks through to the day-long Mt Taranaki summit climb and overnight tramps such as the spectacular Pouakai Circuit.

Intentions

Before you go tramping please tell someone responsible where you are going and your estimated time of arrival back. Intentions for overnight tramps may be left at North Egmont Visitor Centre.

Weather

Weather on Mt Taranaki is very changeable and difficult to predict. Carry enough clothing and equipment to ensure you are prepared to cope with any type of weather.

Contact the MetService (phone 0900 999 24 or www.metservice.com) for up to date weather information. DOC visitor centres also display metservice weather forecasts.

Warning: Rivers and streams are not always bridged and can flood suddenly after heavy rainfall.

Huts

Eight Department of Conservation huts in Egmont National Park offer trampers basic accommodation. Hut tickets are required to stay in all huts. These can be purchased from:

Mountain Guides

The 8 - 10 hour return climb to the summit of Mt Taranaki is challenging and should only be undertaken by experienced trampers. Climbing Mt Taranaki in winter conditions is recommended only for experienced mountaineers or with a qualified guide. Three local mountain guides have Department of Conservation approval to guide tramps to the summit of Mt Taranaki. These are:
