Situated in tranquil native forest with spectacular views of Mt Taranaki, Konini Lodge is self-catering style accommodation for up to 38 people. Located in Egmont National Park at Dawson Falls the lodge is an ideal venue for school parties, backpackers, trampers, family and social groups and nature lovers. It can be booked overnight or as a day venue for meetings, seminars and group activities.

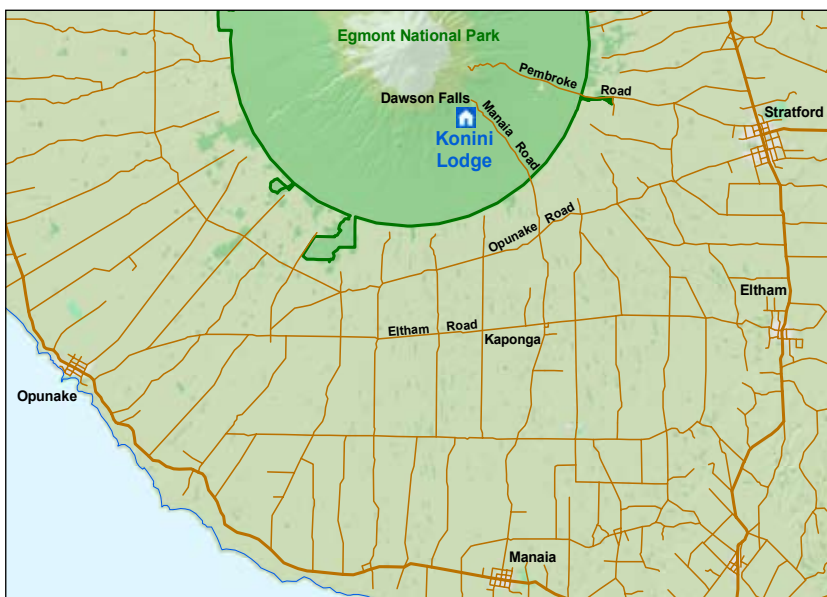
Facilities

- 4 bunkrooms which sleep up to 8 people.
- 2 bunkrooms which sleep up to 3 people.
- 2 separate large living areas with electric heating.
- Communal kitchen equipped with two domestic ovens, microwave, fridge and freezer.
- Men's and Women's bathrooms with hot showers.
- Drying room.

Konini Lodge has a "No Naked Flame Policy".

Follow the signs from Stratford to Dawson Falls, Egmont National Park, located at the end of Manaia Road.



Rates

Night Rates (per night)

- \$20.40 per adult
- \$10.20 per child

(Annual hut passes and hut tickets are not valid at Konini Lodge)

Egmont National Park is an area of unique rainforests and alpine scenery. There are numerous opportunities for hiking, mountaineering, photography, picnicking and just enjoying nature. Konini Lodge is close to some excellent short walks, including the historic Dawson Falls Power Station, Wilkies Pools and the impressive Dawson Falls. A popular longer hike for groups takes in nearby Waingongoro Hut.

The Dawson Falls Visitor Centre near the lodge has information and displays on the park. This is only open certain days of the week. Special arrangements can be made at the time of booking for visits outside opening hours.

Walks and tramps from Konini Lodge

1 to 2 hours

- Kapuni Loop Track to Dawson Falls
- Wilkies Pools Loop Track
- Ridge Loop Track

Half and Full Day tramps

- Waingongoro Track Round Trip
- Lake Dive Round Trip
- Fanthams Peak Return Trip (upper section is very exposed and not recommended when snow and ice are present except for experienced climbers)

Those wishing to tramp or climb in Egmont National Park should purchase an Egmont National Park Map (Infomap 273-09) or the Topo50 map series. Before setting out we advise you contact North Egmont Visitor Centre for updated track information. Phone: (06) 756 0990

Weather and Safety

Egmont National Park is subject to very high rainfall and sudden dramatic weather changes. Anyone going into the park should carry protective clothing, whatever the season. This includes woollen hat, boots, wind and waterproof parka and over trousers.
