## Walking 'in and out' the Golden Bay side

The track between Brown Hut and James Mackay Hut is in good condition and remains open. Visitors can book trips from the Golden Bay side, using Aorere Shelter Campsite, Brown, Perry Saddle, Gouland Downs, Saxon and James Mackay huts and campsites.

Book on the <u>Great Walks online booking system</u>. Existing bookings can be either cancelled (with a full refund) or re-arranged.

## Walking 'in and out' the West Coast side

Visitors can book trips on the West Coast side. The Heaphy Hut/Campsite, Katipo Creek Shelter Campsite and Scotts Beach Campsite remain open.
