
## Decision to investigate biodiversity offsetting—landscape and site



## Back to Decision Tree

- Nearby is likely to be defined and constrained through discussion with stakeholders and peers.
  For example, a district council may wish to see the offset occur within its territorial boundaries, or within a catchment.
- For example, when pest control to increase breeding success is best undertaken at the main breeding population of a migratory bird.
- 3. This project cannot achieve like for like no net loss for significant residual effects. Consider stakeholder-agreed trade up if values lost are low. Otherwise, refine project or consider whether legislative tests can still be met through applying other forms of mitigation/compensation.
