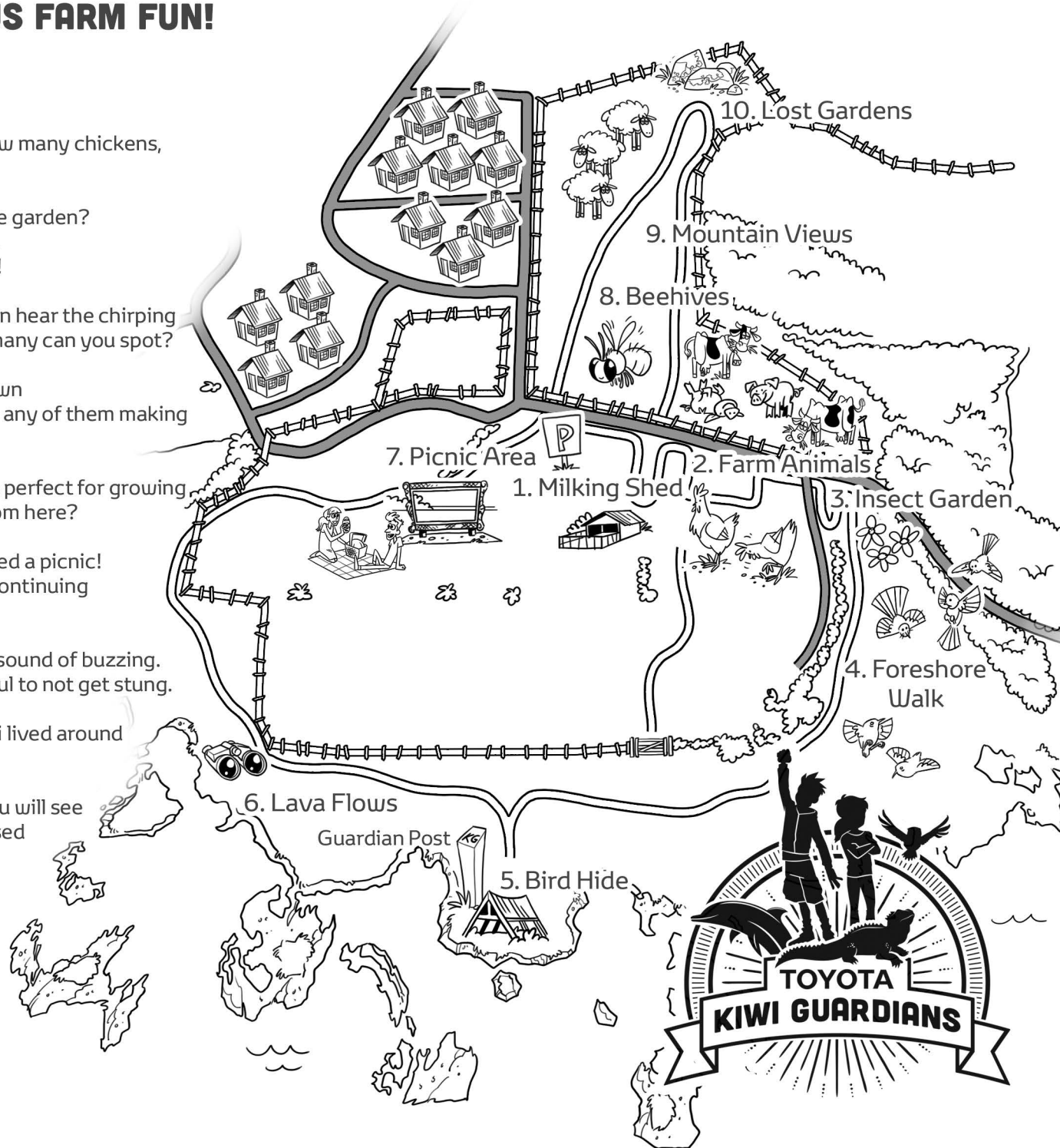


AMBURY REGIONAL PARK – FABULOUS FARM FUN!

1. Milking Shed: Do you know how we get our milk from cows?
2. Farm Animals: Oink oink! Meet the friendly farm animals. How many chickens, pigs and horses can you count?
3. Insect Garden: Can you find any creepy crawlies hiding in the garden? They are very good at playing hide and seek, so look closely. Make sure you watch out for the ongaonga /stinging nettle!!
4. Foreshore Walk: Follow the yellow markers and see if you can hear the chirping birds. There are 86 bird species that live here, WOW!! How many can you spot?
5. Bird Hide: Can you believe that some of these birds have flown all the way from Russia and Alaska to live here!! Can you see any of them making their new homes?
6. Lava Flows: Ash and lava from volcanoes made the soil here perfect for growing plants and farming. Which extinct volcanoes can you see from here?
7. Picnic Area: Time to stop and have a rest, we hope you packed a picnic! Make sure you get a photo in the giant photo frame before continuing your adventure.
8. Beehives: Follow the blue marks and you'll start to hear the sound of buzzing. Can you see any bees making honey in their hives? Be careful to not get stung.
9. Mountain Views: Imagine hundreds of years ago when Māori lived around this maunga / mountain. Where do you think they lived?
10. Lost Gardens: Make your way through the paddocks and you will see the stone mounds. What type of crops do you think Māori used to grow here?
