

## Map 4 - Headwaters of the Clyde River

This map covers the headwaters of the Clyde River. The red line is the helicopter flight path and the small arrows show the direction the helicopter was flying. The black dots are the waypoints that animals were seen. Beside each waypoint there is a three-digit number. Beside each waypoint number in the table below, it has the number of animals seen and the altitude that the animals were at.

- Date Survey flight done – 5<sup>th</sup> August 2018
- Weather conditions – fine, snow present
- Number of groups seen – 25
- Smallest group seen – 2 animals
- Largest group seen – 60 animals
- Total number of animals seen – 427 animals
