Thank you for your Official Information Act (OIA) request to the Department of Conservation, received on 2 August 2023, in which you asked:

"Can you please provide a copy of the permit that allows the three huts at the back of loch katrine and the associated toilet facilities?

Can you also please provide any other supporting documents relating to pricing, as well as any amendments that have occurred to the original permit?"

The huts and associated toilet facilities at Loch Katrine are authorised under Concession Number: CA-251-ACC.

I have decided to release the relevant parts of the documents listed below, subject to information being withheld under the following sections of the OIA, as applicable:

- personal contact details of officials, under section 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons, including deceased people,
- commercially sensitive information, under section 9(2)(b)(ii) to protect the commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or who is the subject of the information,
- commercially sensitive information, under section 9(2)(i) to enable a Minister of the Crown or any department or organisation holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities.
