

Thank you for your email of 30 March 2023 to Predator Free 2050 Limited, requesting information relating to copies of two, respective, Deloitte and MartinJenkins reports.

You requested the following:

[...] copies of the Martin Jenkins and Deloitte reports on Predator Free 2050 Ltd.

On 3 April 2023, Predator Free 2050 Limited transferred your request to the Department of Conservation ('the Department') for response.

On 2 May 2023, we extended the timeframe to respond to your request to 16 May 2023, due to necessary consultation.

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 ('OIA').

Please find attached the review of Predator Free 2050 Limited, carried out, respectively, by Deloitte and MartinJenkins, in 2021. These two reports are being released to you with no withholds or refusals of information under the OIA.

The reports made a number of findings and recommendations. Some of the recommendations were for the Company to address, and the Department has supported it in doing so. Some were for the Department to address and have been actioned by the Department in its work with the Company.
