Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation, transferred from the Minister of Conservation on 22 May 2023, in which you asked for:

"all advice the minister has received from Department of Conservation officials around the potential harms that offshore energy exploration and development might cause to wildlife in the area."

On 20 June 2023, we informed you that we had extended your request until 30 June 2023, due to the consultation necessary to respond to you.

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 and consider the following documents to be in scope.

- commercially sensitive information, under section 9(2)(b)(ii) to protect the
 commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or who is the subject
 of the information,
- free and frank expression under section 9(2)(g)(i) to maintain the effective conduct
 of public affairs,

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the Official Information Act and determined there are no public interests that outweigh the grounds for withholding.

You are entitled to seek an investigation and review of my decision by writing to an Ombudsman as provided by section 28(3) of the Official Information Act.
