Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation, received on 11 June 2023, in which you asked for:

'How much does the Department of Conservation spend on maintaining the Abel Tasman National Park annually?

Could I please have this itemised by year for the last 10 years if possible, and inclusive of all costs incurred by the park, including paying for staff, track and road maintenance, cmapsite maintenance and monitoring, transport, pest management, outreach & education, land costs, rent, etc. I would like this to include only departmental spending. Essentially if you were to treat the park as a single line-item on the government books, how much would it cost? If exact numbers aren't available, an approximation or estimate would also be

acceptable.

Also, does the department maintain any figures on the estimated economic benefits of the National Park, or is this a question better directed towards the Ministry of Tourism?'

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982.

Your questions and our responses are listed below:

 How much does the Department of Conservation spend on maintaining the Abel Tasman National Park annually? Could I please have this itemised by year for the last 10 years if possible, and inclusive of all costs incurred by the park, including paying for staff, track and road maintenance, cmapsite maintenance and monitoring, transport, pest management, outreach & education, land costs, rent, etc. I would like this to include only departmental spending. Essentially if you were to treat the park as a single line-item on the government books, how much would it cost? If exact numbers aren't available, an approximation or estimate would also be acceptable.'

The maintenance costs for the Abel National Park for the Department of Conservation (only), as a line item for each year is detailed in the table below. We have provided information for the last 7 years, as beyond that period, the information we hold is incomplete due to a previous accounting system used at that time.
