Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation (DOC), received on 4 July 2025, in which you asked for:

"Under the Official Information Act 1982, I request the following information:

- Copies of any briefings, memos, or correspondence sent to or received from the Minister of Tourism and/or the Minister of Conservation regarding the Subantarctic commercial tourism fee increases or associated review.
- 2. Records of any meetings held with the Minister(s) or their offices on this subject, including:
 - 1. Agendas.
 - 2. Meeting notes or minutes.
 - 3. Policy papers
 - 4. Follow-up communications.
- 3. Any formal advice prepared for Ministers explaining the rationale for the increases or potential implications for operators.

If any part of this request is too broad, I am happy to refine the time frame to the last five years."

On 17 July 2025, your request was partially transferred to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment under section 14 of the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA), as that Ministry may hold information related to any material provided to the Minister of Tourism.

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA).

In line with the note in your request, we have considered information from the past five years to be in scope, so the request is not as broad.

Decisions on Subantarctic Island fee increases were internally made by DOC and were not a Ministerial decision. The Department updated the Minister of Conservation on this topic as required for meeting preparation and on a no surprises basis.



There are two documents that contain information in scope of your request:
