Subject: Update for Charlie

Kia ora Team

Just a quick update from me since we are meeting tomorrow. I wanted to flag the follow concerns for discussion. has been onsite from Thursday the 5th Sep that we know of, she has since been on-site every day since filming, video recording, posting video content and doing her own timed observations of the kaka here at the BG with a particular focus on Charlie.

I was off Friday to Sunday.

From Monday I started to observe Charlie's behaviour while was on site and over the last few days, I can say confidently that Charlie's behaviour has changed from what we have been seeing. I am witnessing an increase in Charlie's swaying times since has been on site recording. On Tuesday I asked to please be respectful of the space and move away from the front area of Charlies enclosure where she had her camera on a tripod set up, filming and loudly talking on and off all day. She moved herself a few meters back from Charlie's enclosure which I thanked her for.

This morning we noted that Charlie had not eaten, and my concern now is presence is directly compromising the welfare of this kaka. I would like to weigh her and ask that members of our verteam (to advise) be present to help us as everything inside Charlie's enclosure is being recorded and posted on social media with a negative and out of context connotation. I would like to check Charlie's weight to assess she hasn't lost any since has been on-site.

We should talk about what the next steps will be if she has.

Kia ora korua

asked me to assist with locating obs notes when I got back from leave, but I am keen to help sooner.

All our detailed recent obs are of Rata, Charlie gets a mention, but she was not the focus or our concern so comments around her behaviour were incidental. I hope this info from me will be helpful. Charlie's usual behaviour involves being quite active over all areas of her cage such as perches, netting walls and netting ceiling. She loves to bathe and will submerge herself and roll onto her side in the water. I think she will be enjoying the misters in her Dunedin aviary. In recent years we have noticed that Charlie rests out of public view more than other kākā we have kept with or beside her. We have only seen her fly if panicked, or in pursuit of her target stick during training, and these have only been short flights, so far. Charlie is quite vocal and will engage in a good dawn screaming session with other birds and she and Jimmy used to do a call and response throughout the day.

Unsurprisingly, given her long captive history, Charlie loves people, especially children and school groups in particular. She doesn't like people in her aviary, not even her keepers sometimes, but she loves them through the netting and will come down to 'dance' and whistle for people. She really enjoys fresh vegetation, which will sometimes keep her engaged for hours. She responds well to other enrichments including puzzle feeders. She's not much of a chewer or branch stripper (other than broadleaf which she will strip in the pre-breeding and breeding seasons).

Behaviours we notice when Charlie is uncomfortable are raised head feathers, hanging on vertical netting by her beak (feet on perch or holding onto netting), biting left foot, limping. We wondered if the damage to the feathers on her right wing could have been barbing in response to pain. Prior to getting her medication sorted we sometimes found her unwilling to engage and spending more time on her perch, slightly fluffed.

The stereotypical behaviour we used to see has finally disappeared. She only swings these days in panic situations such as when we are catching an aviary mate. This swinging, either on the netting wall or ceiling, was something she once did for hours at a stretch. It is similar to the happy dance she briefly does for people but the two could not be confused.

Pre-breeding, Charlie becomes aggressively territorial and picky about who she will tolerate in her aviary. She spends more time on the aviary floor and generally looking around for potential nest sites. Aggressive behaviour stops as soon as eggs are laid, and once chicks are hatched she is absolutely fine with them being checked and weighed.

Released Under the While her appetite goes up and down through the year, her weight remains amazingly stable at 480g. She climbs on the scales willingly for weighing, providing we watch from behind the aviary door. That is all I can think of, and I hope it will be helpful.

Observations

Charlie – while still at park, look out for any signs of issues with arthritis. Not closing toes & claws around perch. Wearing lion mane (feathers up on back of neck). Movement in general around enclosure.

Jimmy – general behaviour, familiarity, and ease of getting around surroundings in enclosure. Video footage if possible.

While together interactions between the birds.
