

Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation, received on 17 December 2024, in which you asked for:

"..any technical reports, data, field studies or assessments, or other associate material, prepared by or held by the Department of Conservation and/or consultants engaged by the Department of Conservation, regarding the presence and location of the following species in the Dunstan Ranges and wider Central Otago Area:

- (a) Ceratocephala pungens.
- (b) Myosorus minimus.
- (c) Myosotis brevis.

On 24 December 2024, you refined your request's specific area of interest to the Dunstan Ranges and confirmed one of the species of interest as *Myosurus minimus* as opposed to *Myosorus minimus*.

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

The conservation status of a species is a forecast based on observed trends and likely pressures (refer to <u>Conservation status of plants and animals: Nature</u>). Of the plant species listed and confirmed as being the subject of your request, *Ceratocephala pungens* and *Myosurus minimus* are nationally critical, while *Myosotis brevis* is nationally endangered.

A schedule of the documents identified as within the scope of your refined request is attached. I have decided to release the relevant parts of these documents, subject to some information being withheld under one or more of the following sections of the OIA, as applicable:

- personal (contact) details, under section 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons, including deceased people, and/or
- specific locations of threatened plant and animal species, under section 6(c) to limit undesirable activity connected to threatened species, as making such information available is likely to prejudice the maintenance of the law, including the prevention, investigation, and detection of offences.

In making my decision to withhold certain information under section 9, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the OIA and determined there are no public interests that outweigh the grounds for withholding.

I note that some of the documents being released (in full or in part) contain:

- information outside the scope of your request: This information has been withheld and I have indicated on the document schedule attached where this type of withholding has occurred.
- information relating to the wider Central Otago District: Where appropriate, this information has been left in to provide additional context.
- references to other documents: These other documents have not been included as part of our response.

You are entitled to seek an investigation and review of my decision by writing to an Ombudsman as provided by section 28(3) of the OIA.
