

Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation (the Department), received on 29 January 2025, in which you asked for:

"Mean, minimum and maximum times for completion of first complete assessment for the following permit application types in 2023 and 2024:

- Scientific research in a marine reserve
- Wildlife Act Authority (General form 9) and
- Research and Collection Authorisation (form 10)
- A breakdown of these statistics by region if possible/applicable."

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

We have extracted the data on application times from information held by the Department in the Permissions Database in the following table.

Notes on the data:


- Numbers are based on applications received in calendar years 2023 and 2024.
- Date calculations are in working days, from the date of receipt of the complete application to the decision date.
- · Applications which have not yet reached decision are excluded.
