Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation (DOC), received on 27 March 2025, in which you asked for:

- "1. All advice provided by DOC to the Minister of Conservation, the Minister of Finance or the Treasury relating to support or funding for Puketahā, a proposed fenced wildlife sanctuary in the Wainuiomata water collection area.
- 2. Any commentary on or response to this advice that DOC may have received from other branches of central Government.
- 3. Any DOC analysis reports, memos or briefing notes pertaining to this proposal
- 4. Any correspondence specifically between DOC and any Minister about this proposal."

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA).
