- Please advise what this 'hidden' information refers to?
- Please advise why this information has NOT been released to the public.
- Is this 'information' relating to carbon dating?
- Does it show evidence of human occupation PRIOR to Maori?
- Please provide all reports/findings from the above archaelogical investigation.

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA).

Your request is refused under section 18(d) of the OIA as the information is publicly available.
