Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation (DOC), received on 13 October 2025, in which you asked for:





- Please can you provide details for all hunting balloted permitted/restricted blocks in terms of the number of ballots actually permitted each year, and the duration of each ballot period e.g. x weeks/months etc.*
- Please can you provide the raw data behind that latest Public Pulse of Conservation survey, so that I can see all the details for hunting and other recreational activities including the protected natural areas that they are visiting.*

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA).

On 16 October 2025 you were contacted by one of my staff to clarify your request and has been recently confirmed. You refined your request to:

- Please provide any hunting ballot data that is readily available, recognising that these permits are in a paper format and held across multiple District Offices.*
- Please narrow my Pulse of Conservation survey data request to just the 2024 calendar year and for hunting.*

The data you requested is listed in the table below and provided as an attachment to this letter.
