Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation (DOC), received on 18 September 2025, in which you asked for:

"a copy of the leasehold agreement between the Department of Conservation and Salmon Smolt NZ for the operation of the salmon hatchery at 430 Heywards Road, Clarkville, in the Waimakariri District of Canterbury, legal description RS 42293 BLKS II III CHCH SD - SO 16577 16578 16789 SO 16789 SILVERSTREAM FISH HATCHERY."

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA).

Two documents fall in scope of your request.

The Concession for the lease of *Local Purpose Reserve – Fish Hatchery – The Croft* was originally granted in 2003 to the National Institute of Water and Atmospheric Research Ltd (NIWA) which you will see in the first document.

The lease was then reassigned, as you will see outlined in the second document, to Salmon Smolt New Zealand Limited in 2008 who took on all *covenants, terms and conditions* of the original Concession.
