Thank you for your request to the Department of Conservation, received on 26 May 2025, in which you asked:

"Under the OIA, can I please have copies of all aide memoirs, briefings, memos, notes, reports, or any other advice, sent to the Minister or their offices regarding funding decisions for your department/ministry and votes you are responsible for, in the context of Budget 2025. This includes all Budget 2025 bids for funding, impacts of funding decisions in Budget 25, and impacts of not receiving funding in Budget 2025. This can be limited to 1 November 2024 to today.

Under the OIA, I also request copies of all aide memoirs, briefings, memos, notes, reports, or any other advice, sent to your executive leadership team regarding funding decisions for departments and votes you are responsible for, in the context of Budget 2025. This includes all Budget 2025 bids for funding, impacts of funding decisions in Budget 25, and impacts of not receiving funding in Budget 2025. This can be limited to 1 November 2024 to today.

If and where a document that falls under scope of this request cannot be released, please supply a summary of that document's contents.

If and where any document falls under the scope of this request, please release it in full, including sections which might otherwise be considered out of scope"

We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

On 16 June 2025, we extended the timeframe to respond to your request to 8 August 2025, due to the large quantity of information sought and the consultation necessary.

The Department's response to this OIA request includes all advice provided to the Minister of Conservation and his Office, and the Senior Leadership Team - including draft package options and final templates for submission. It is limited to the period 1 November 2024 to 26 May 2025.

Final Budget decisions for the Department have been made and can be found here.



I have decided to release the documents listed in the attached Schedule of documents, subject to information being withheld under one or more of the following sections of the OIA, as applicable:

- personal information, under section 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons, including deceased people,
- commercially sensitive information, under section 9(2)(b)(ii) to protect the commercial
  position of the person who supplied the information, or who is the subject of the
  information.
- advice (still) under consideration, section 9(2)(f)(iv) to maintain the current constitutional conventions protecting the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers and officials,
- free and frank expression of opinions, under section 9(2)(g)(i) by, between or to
  Ministers or members of an organisation or officers and employees of any public service
  agency or organisation in the course of their duty to maintain the effective conduct of
  public affairs,
- advice subject to legal privilege, under section 9(2)(h) to maintain legal professional privilege,
- commercially sensitive information, under section 9(2)(i) to enable a Minister or any public service agency or organisation holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities, and
- confidential information, under section 9(2)(j) to enable a Minister or any public service agency or organisation holding the information to negotiate without disadvantage or prejudice.

The attached Schedule of documents incorporates a brief summary of content for each document, as requested.

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the OIA and determined there are no public interests that outweigh the grounds for withholding.
