9(2)(a) and Reefton Gold reluctantly agree to withdraw the AA application 121210-AA and submit immediately a revised application. The revisions address the points in DOC's request for further information (RFI) from October 2025 (each point is addressed in a separate document attached and the information included in the revised application) as well as minor changes to drill site locations that were recommended by the consultants to avoid ecologically sensitive areas. Note also that pump sites and water extraction has been relocated to outside the public conservation land and into river catchments outside Natural State water classifications.

Please find a new AA application attached, that we would consider of sufficient standard and completeness for DOC to proceed directly to Iwi consultation and decision making expeditiously. We would also request that this new application remains at the top of the queue for processing (as assured by Rebecca), and that DOC will commence the processing immediately and with priority. We would request that this priority processing provision be put in writing please.

Appendices will be sent in a separate email shortly due to size – note that the archaeology report has low resolution photos and maps due to the large size of the original file. If you would like a high res copy, please let me know and I can provide a link for download. Please also note that we are waiting on flora and fauna management plans from Bioresarches (Appendices D–I referred to in the application), which we are assured will be completed by Tuesday. I will send these through to you as soon as I receive them.

We appreciate that we are submitting this beyond your requested time frames, but several factors outside of our control have led to this (see attached timeline): the AA application took three months between initial submission in July and request for further information mid-October, and the WAA took 4.5 months to process before being granted on 12 December. Following the late granting of the WAA, Bioresarches immediately got to work on the targeted fauna surveys by deploying bat monitors; however, the Christmas break delayed the remainder of the work into the New Year. The targeted fauna surveys (especially for the Archey's frog) were restricted to suitable conditions and the final surveys were only able to be completed on 28 February, after which time Bioresarches had to compile the final report. The archaeological surveys were completed in late January, with the report received in mid-March. This re-submission of the AA application immediately follows the delivery of the final ecological impact assessment from Bioresarches to us on 31 March.

We trust that this timeline illustrates the significant efforts we have made to expedite this process, while also taking care to meet all requirements to the highest standard possible. The reasons for delay have been out of our control, with processing timelines and weather conditions being the main contributors.

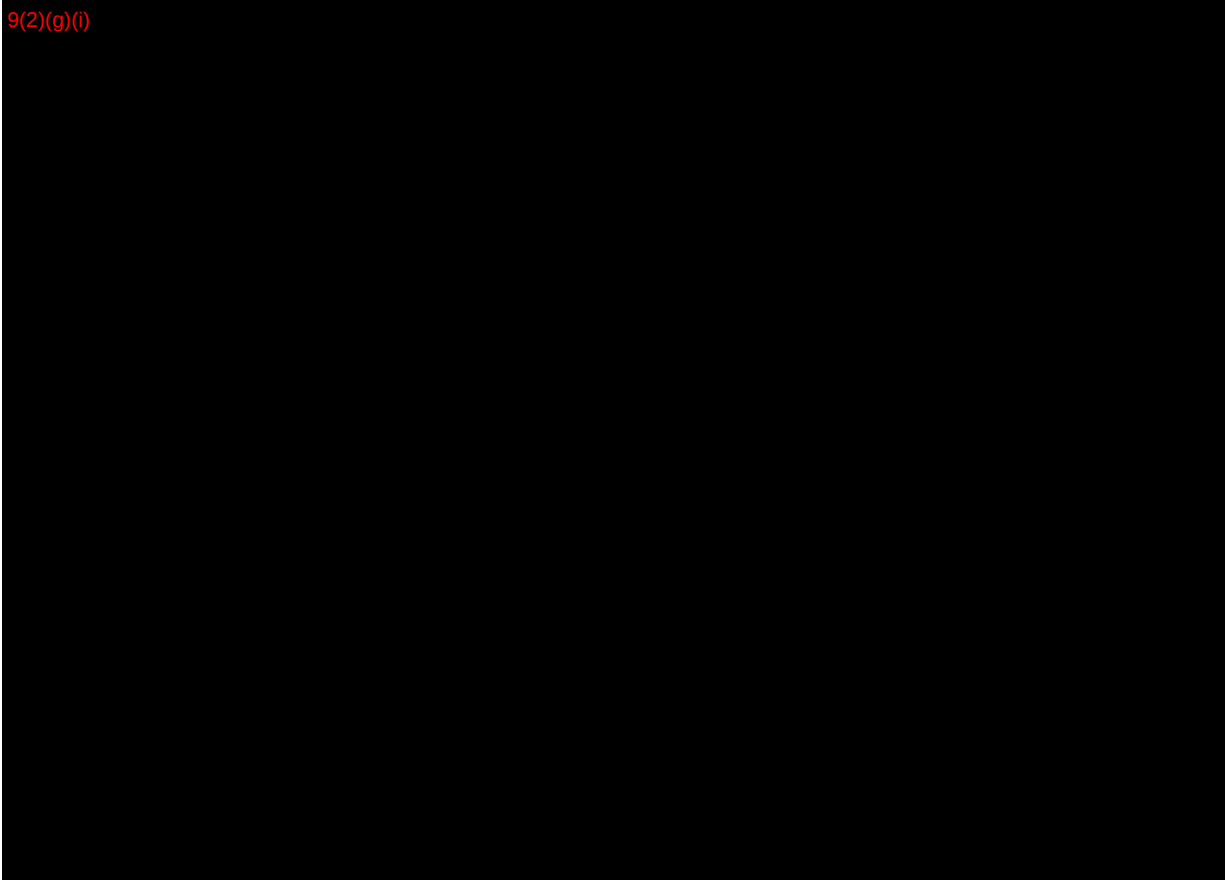

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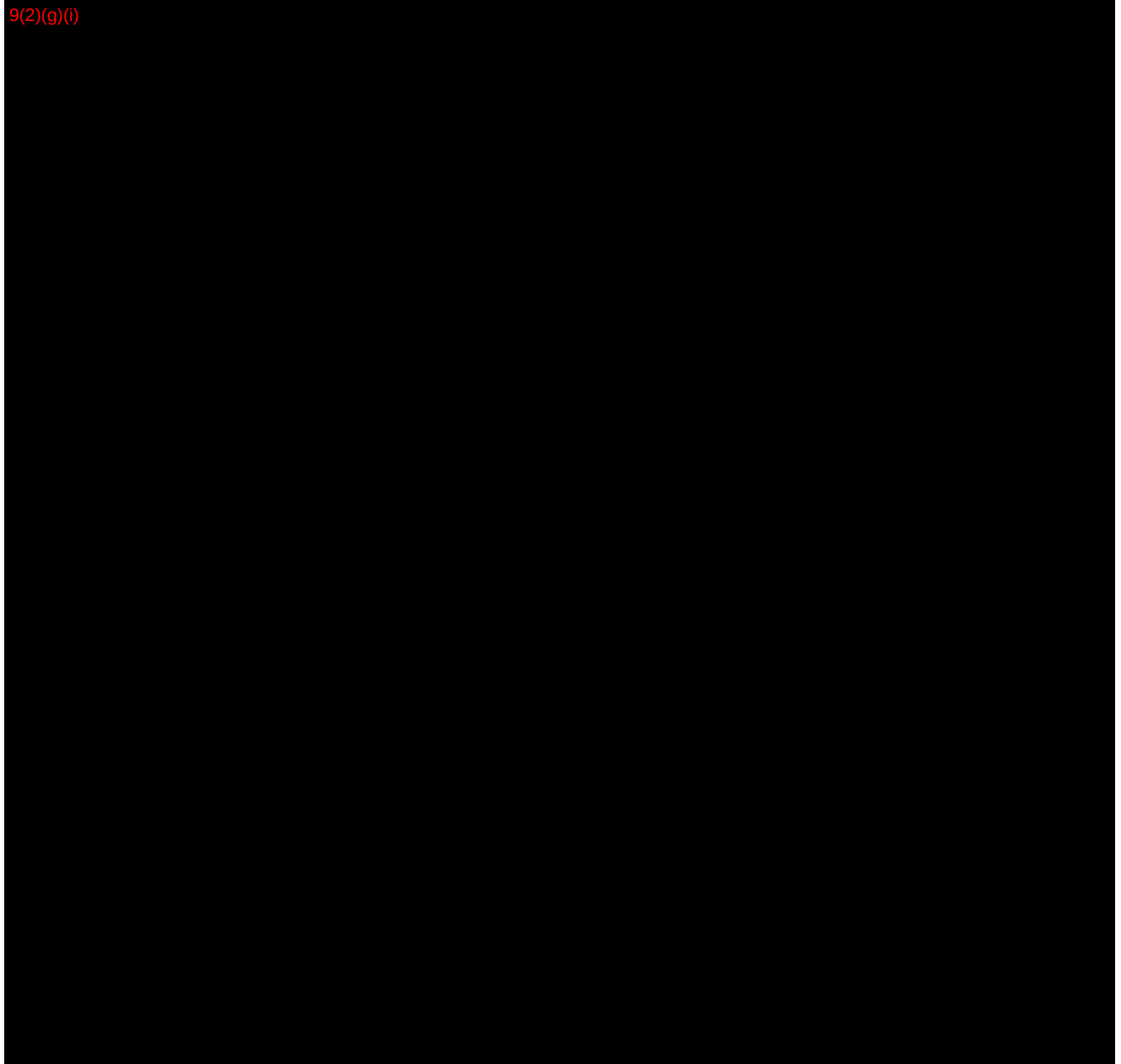
