OBJECTIVE 1

Eradicate / control pests from Mount Taranaki

- Eradicate goats from the National Park
- Control predators and browsers
- Eradicate weeds

Outcomes – forest regeneration, native species and ecosystem services are secure



OBJECTIVE 2

Species recovery

Outcomes – Lost or depleted species will be restored, with regional and national benefits

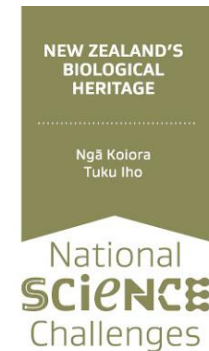

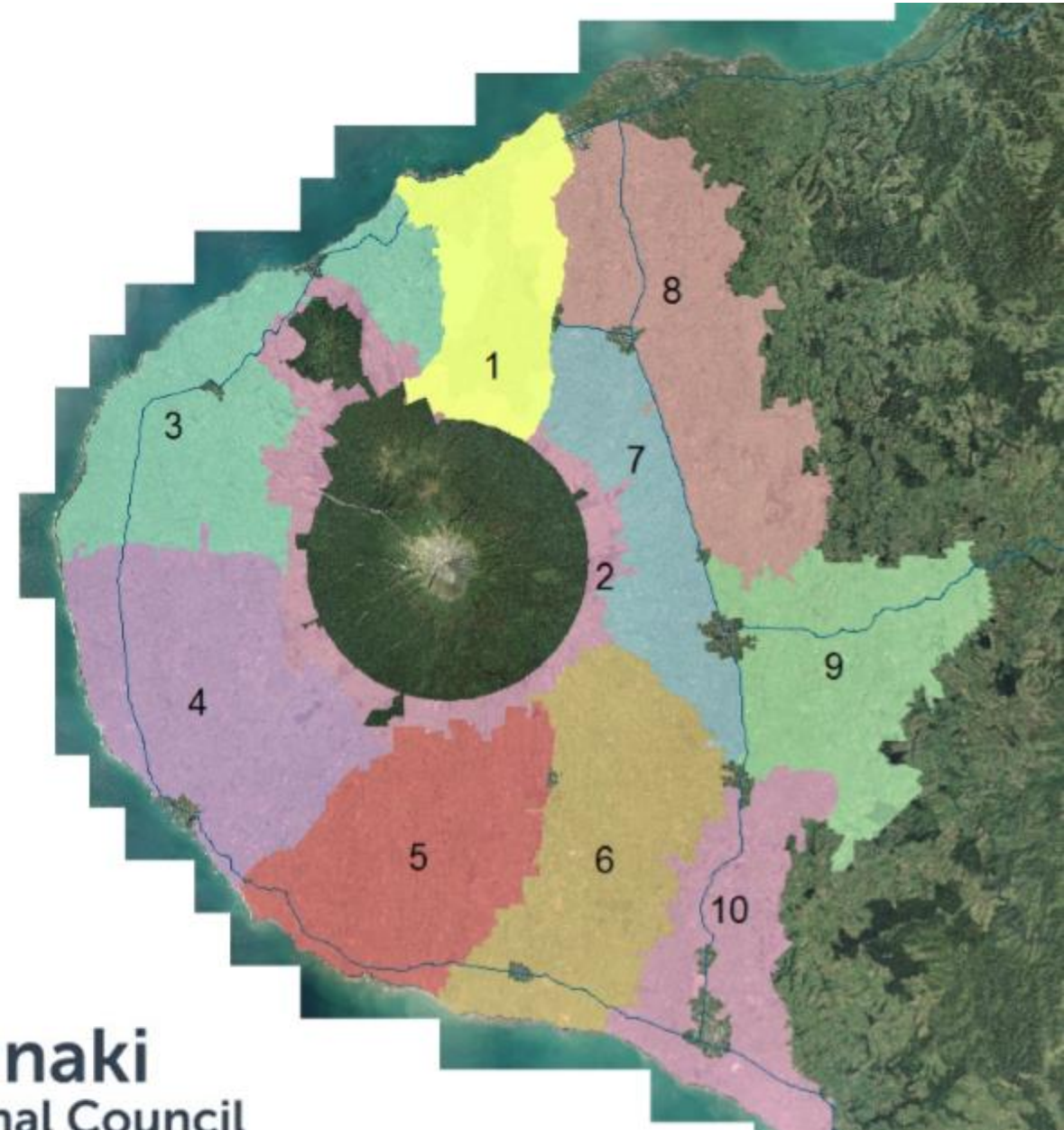

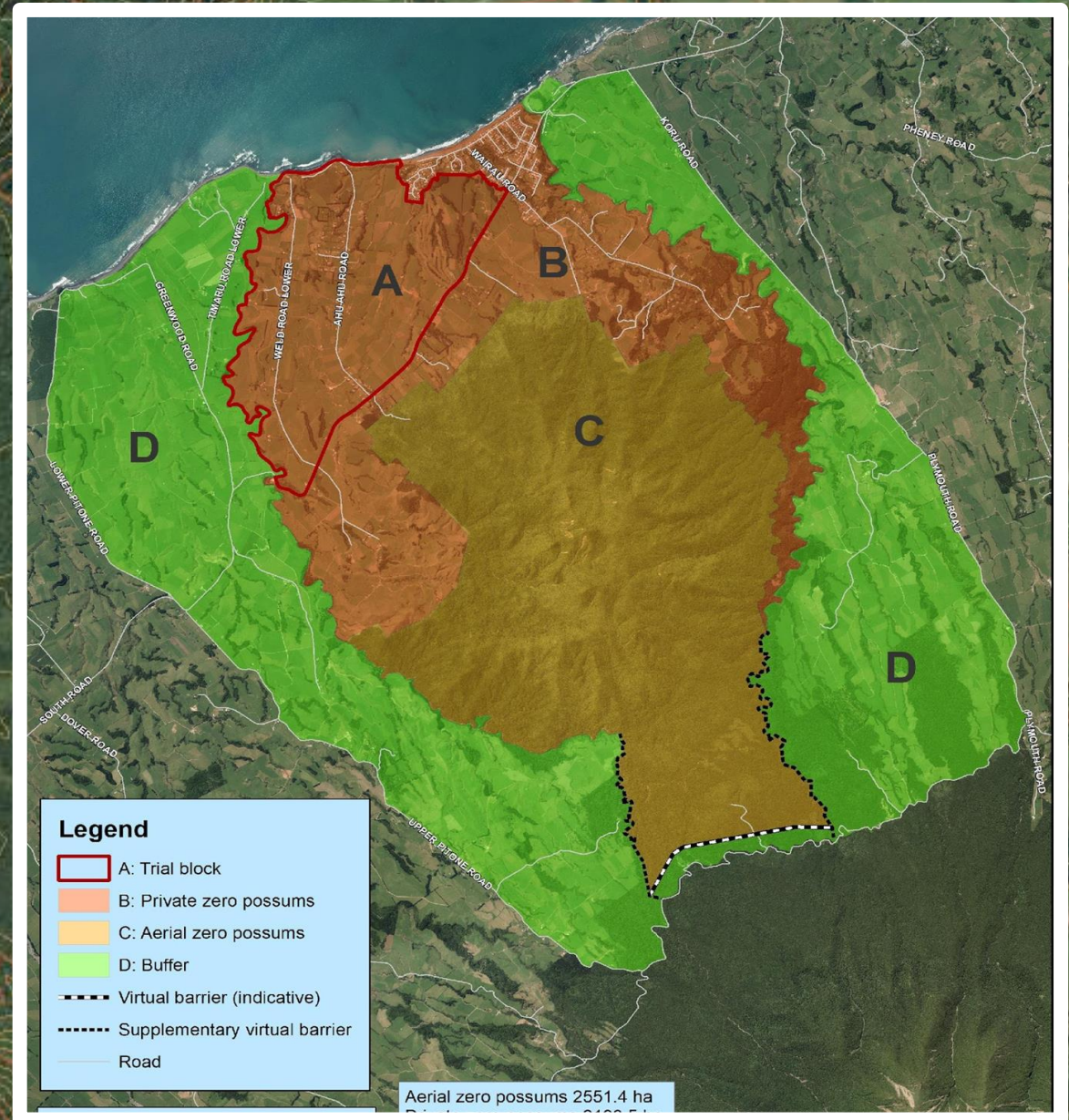
