Context

The Department Of Conservation (DOC) is New Zealand's largest provider of outdoor recreation spaces and opportunities. Like Protected Natural Area management agencies around the world, DOC recognises that there are multiple barriers preventing people with disabilities accessing the multiple benefits of outdoor recreation, and is wanting to address these barriers. Similarly, Recreation Aotearoa (RA), New Zealand's preeminent organisation for recreation professionals, is working to assist its members to identify and eliminate barriers through its 'Accessible Outdoors' initiative, launched in 2022 with support from Sports New Zealand's Disability Inclusion Fund.

However, very little research has been done in Aotearoa New Zealand, or elsewhere, on the outdoor recreation aspirations and experiences of people with disabilities and tāngata whaikaha Māori. As a result, providers of outdoor recreation spaces and opportunities lack the understanding needed to design, develop and deliver better services for people with disabilities.

To address this knowledge gap, DOC and RA partnered to undertake the Outdoor Recreation Accessibility Survey 2024. This foundational research directly engaged with people with disabilities as well as their family/whānau/friends and support persons, to capture unprecedented visibility of the outdoor recreation aspirations and experiences of New Zealand's diverse disability community. The survey was designed by DOC and implemented by RA with assistance from key disability stakeholder groups.

Research Design

Sampling Design

Target Population

The target population for the evaluation comprised:

• All persons with disability residing in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Sampling Frame

The sampling frame for the target population was:

• All persons with disability who are registered with a disability stakeholder group in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Sampling Technique

Two non-random sampling techniques were employed to generate a self-selected sample. The primary technique was via stakeholder groups representing specific disability communities across Aotearoa New Zealand circulating to their memberships an email invitation to the on-line survey.

The secondary technique was via snowballing, with recipients of the invitation email encouraged to share the invitation with their own contacts.

Sample size

To achieve a Margin of Error (MoE) of 5% at the 95% Confidence Level (CL), the target sample size was set at:

• A minimum of 385 fully completed questionnaires.





Data Collection Method

Survey

A quantitative survey instrument (see Appendix 1) was hosted on the SurveyMonkey on-line survey platform for a period of 10 weeks A screen-reader compatible version of the survey was also made available.

Given the exploratory nature of the research, the survey content was deliberately expansive, requiring respondents to potentially invest significant time depending upon their answers. An incentive was offered in recognition of the commitment required.

Support for respondents was immediately available via phone or email for the duration of the survey period.

Results

Survey Response

Sample Size

A self-selected sample of n=702 survey responses was generated, yielding MoE 3.6% at 95% CL.

Sample Demographics

The sample gender distribution was: 'Female' 57.1%; 'Male' 39.6%; 'Another gender' 2.8%.

The dominant age groupings were: 50-54 (11.4%); 35-39 (9.8%); Under 14 (9.4%)

The large majority of respondents were New Zealand European (83.8%), followed by Māori (17.9%).

Response Overview

Responses were collected either directly from the person with disability (n=462), or from a third party legally authorised to respond on their behalf (n=213).

Screen-reader responses (n=20) were subsequently integrated into the total response set A small number of responses (n=27) were also collected from providers of services to people with disability, and these have been included in this report.

The survey achieved a completion rate of 77%, with an average completion time of 24 minutes, 8 seconds.

An unknown number of invitations were distributed, such that it was not possible to calculate the response rate.

Key Findings

Engaging in Outdoor Recreation

- 86% of respondents engage in outdoor recreation.
- The three most common reasons preventing respondents from engaging in outdoor recreation as often as they would like are: 'Finding a place that is suitable for/caters to my disability' (59%); 'My lack of mobility' (45%); 'Ease of access to suitable places' (44%).





- 66.0% of respondents rely on assistance from devices and/or animals to engage in outdoor recreation.
- 9.5% of respondents engage in outdoor recreation 'Every day', with a further 25.7% engaging '2-3 times per week'.
- The most preferred duration of outdoor recreation experiences is '1-3 hours' (35.6%).
- Almost half of respondents (43.9%) 'Agree totally' with the statement 'I would like to engage in outdoor recreation more often'.
- A third of respondents (33.2%) 'Agree totally' with the statement 'I prefer to engage in outdoor recreation with other people'.
- Over a third of respondents (37.9%) 'Agree totally' with the statement 'I rely completely on others to transport me to outdoor recreation places'.
- A quarter of respondents (25.0%) 'Agree totally' with the statement 'I rely completely on others to support/supervise me when I engage in outdoor recreation'.
- The 'Completeness' and 'Accuracy' of information about 'Accessible' locations rated very poorly, as did the Standard' and 'Maintenance' of 'Accessible' infrastructure.
- The most important 'Factor when choosing an outdoor recreation location' is 'Road access 2-wheel drive'.
- The three most important 'Services and facilities when choosing an outdoor recreation place' are: 'Signs/signage'; 'Accessible toilets'; 'Accessible car parks'.
- The three most important 'Trail/pathway attributes when choosing an outdoor recreation place' are: 'Trail structures'; 'Trail surface'; 'Trail gradient'.

Most Recent Outdoor Recreation Experience

- 79.0% of respondents returned to a location where they had previously engaged in outdoor recreation.
- 'Family/whanau/friends' was by far the most common source of information used by respondents (38.9%), followed by generalist information websites (18.2%).
- \bullet Over half (50.6%) of respondents identified 'Short trail journey' as their outdoor recreation activity.
- Overall, respondents rated highly the adequacy of their 'Equipment', 'Experience', 'Information' and 'Skills' to 'Complete their outdoor recreation activity safely'.
- Following their experience, a quarter of respondents (25.8%) 'Agreed totally' with the statement 'I felt safe at all times while at the location'; in contrast, 7.2% 'Did not agree at all'.
- During their experience, 14.9% of respondents 'Encountered a significant difficulty/hazard that was not expected'.
- During their experience, 11.1% of respondents reported they 'Needed better/more clothing and/or equipment'.
- Following their experience, more than half of respondents stated they were 'More likely' to: 'Engage in the same outdoor recreation activity' (57.3%); 'Revisit the same outdoor recreation place' (57.6%); 'Visit new outdoor recreation places' (56.7%).

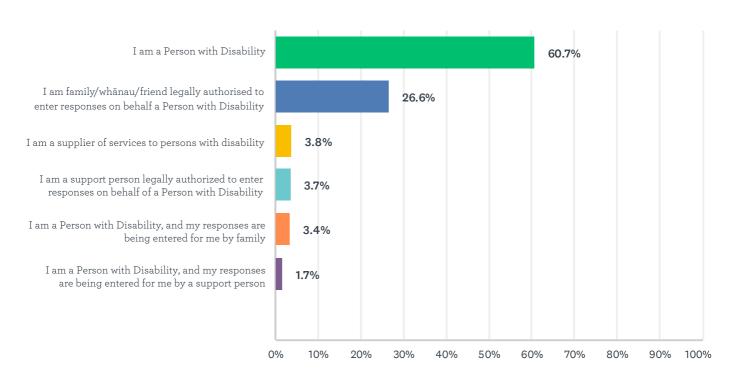
Future Outdoor Recreation Experiences

• 60.0% of respondents stated they would 'Like places to provide [a variety of] additional facilities and services' to improve their outdoor recreation experience.

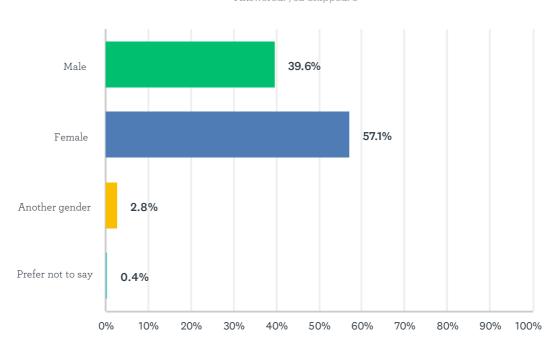

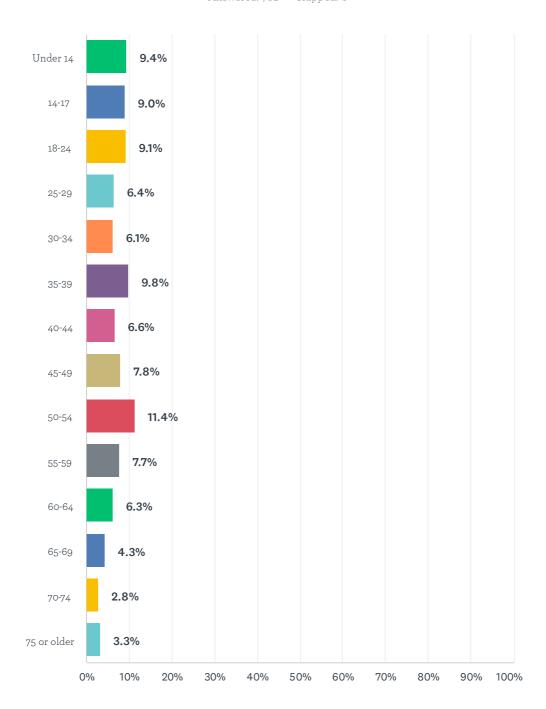
Q3 What is your GENDER?







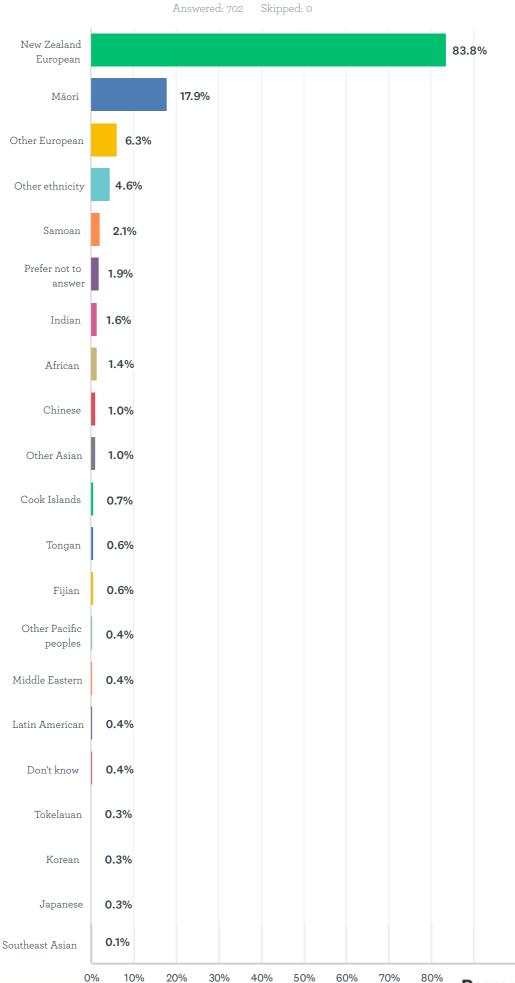
Q4 What is your AGE?

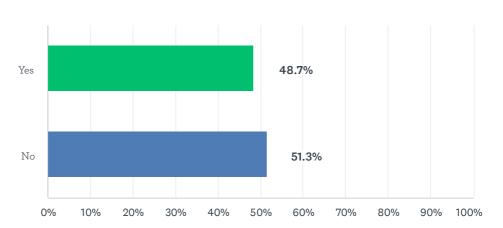

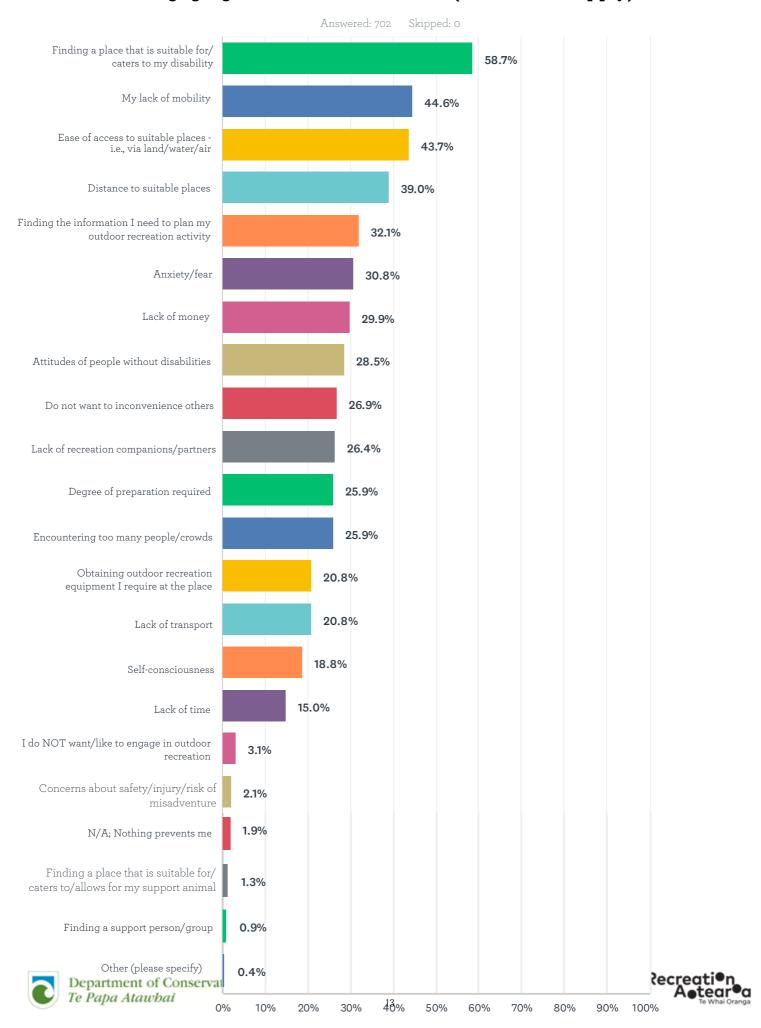
Q10 Do you engage in OUTDOOR recreation?



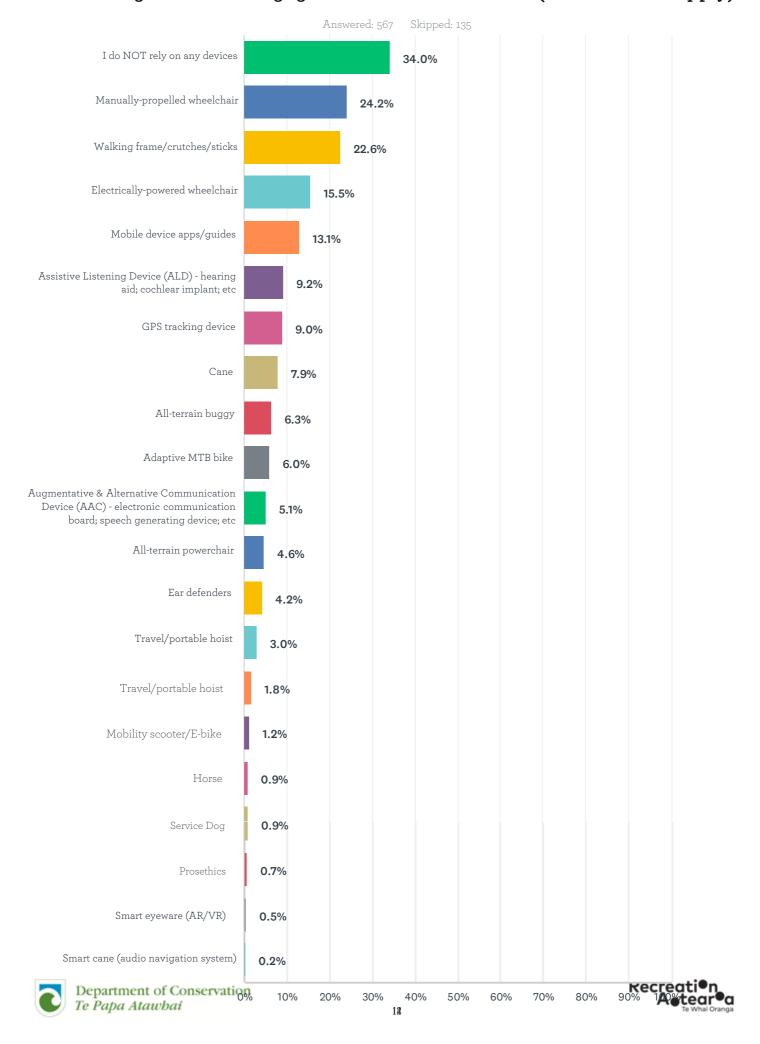




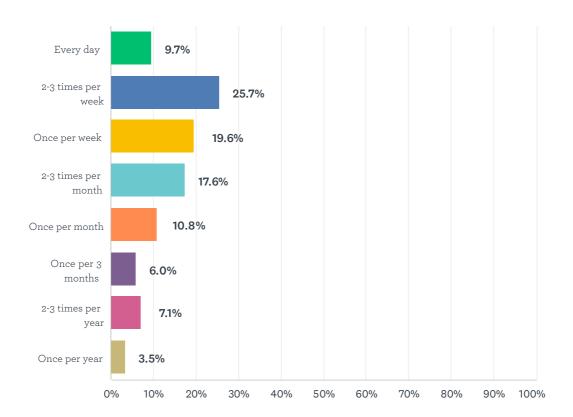
Q11 Which, if any, of the following reasons PREVENT you from engaging in outdoor recreation? (Tick all that apply)

Q13 How OFTEN do you engage in outdoor recreation?

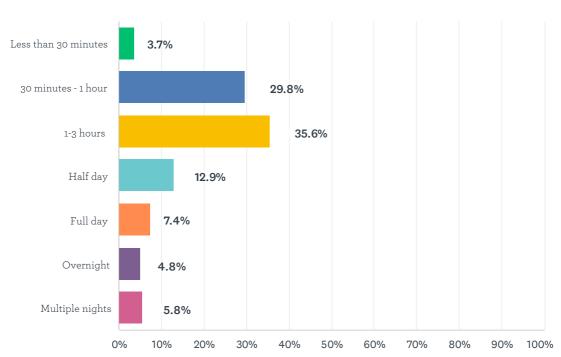






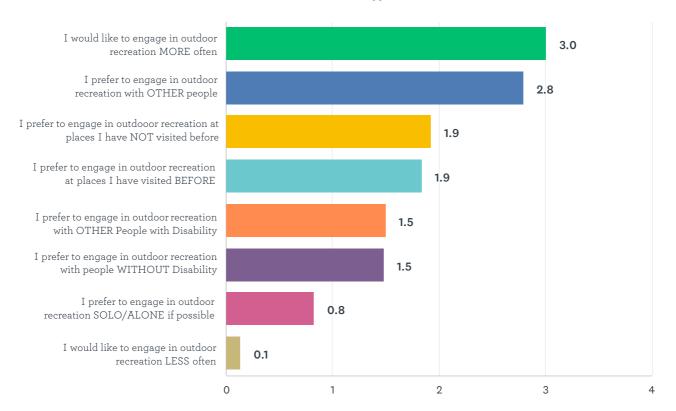
Q14 How much TIME do you prefer your outdoor recreation experiences to take?







Q15 (Thinking about recreating in the outdoors) How much do you AGREE with the following statements?

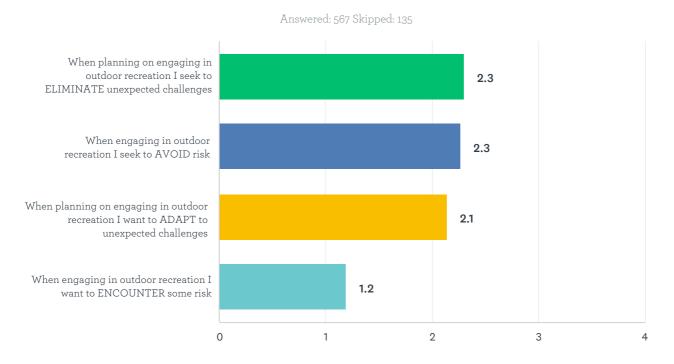

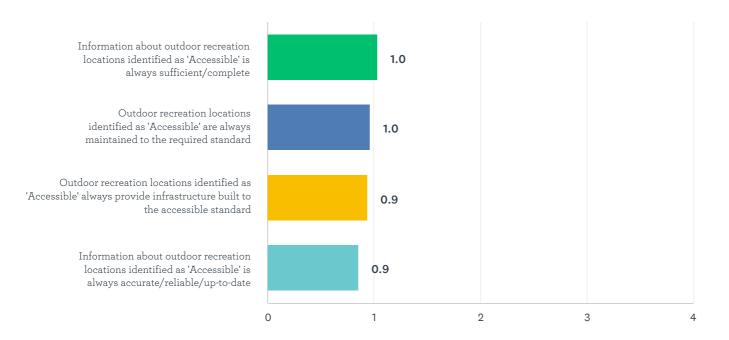

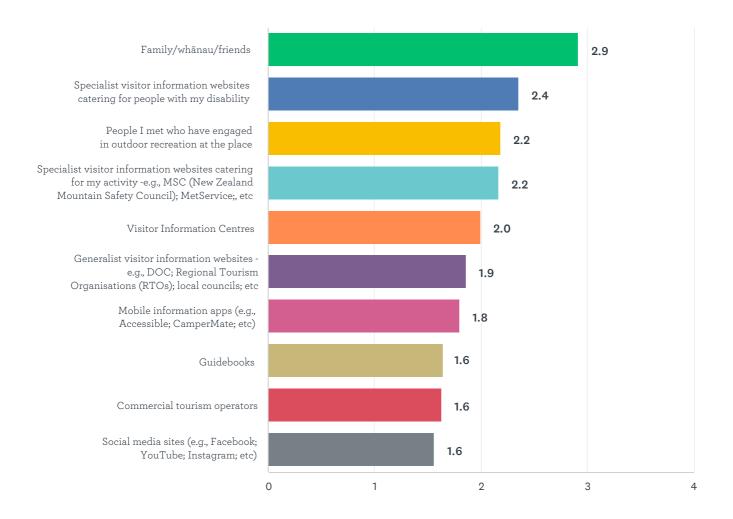

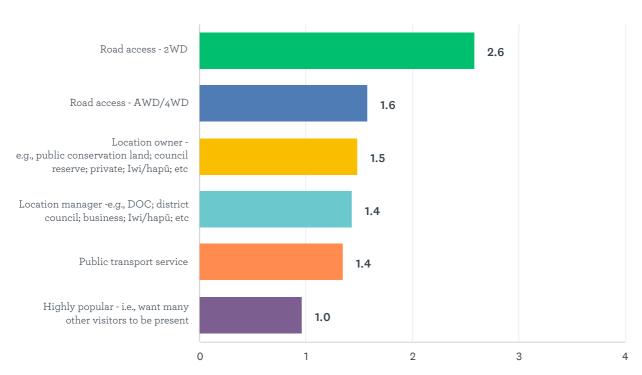

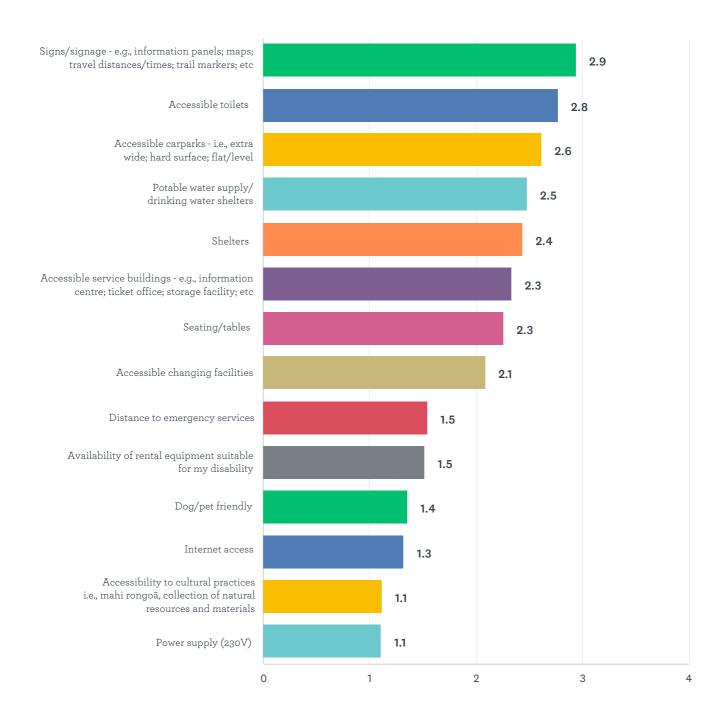

Q22 How IMPORTANT to you are the following SERVICES and FACILITIES when choosing an outdoor recreation PLACE?





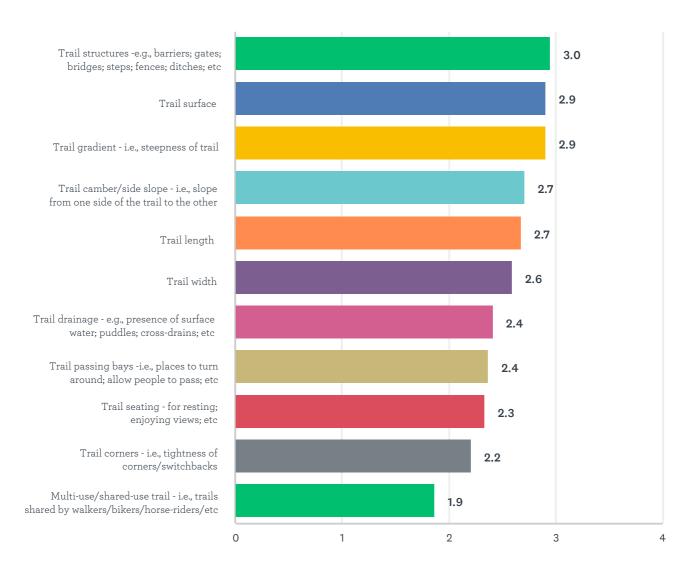

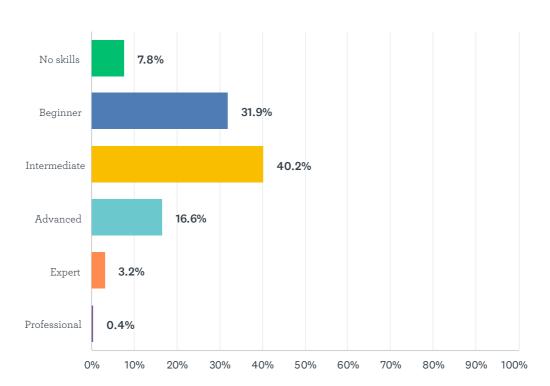

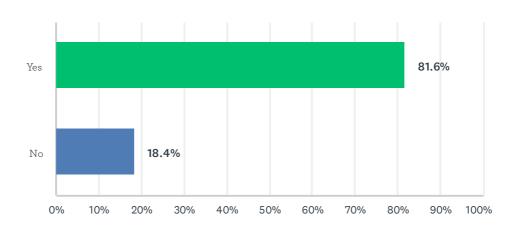


Q24 (Thinking about your preferred outdoor recreation activity) How would you RATE your current level of SKILL?

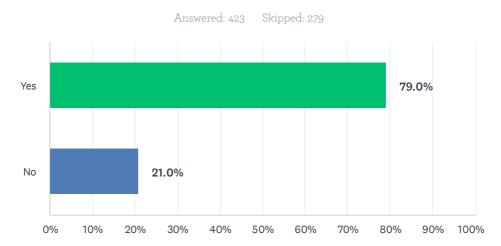
Q25 Have you engaged in the outdoor recreation in the PAST 12 WEEKS?







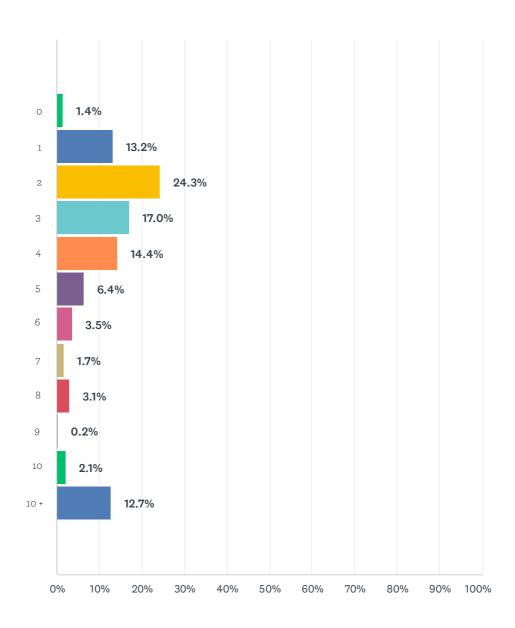

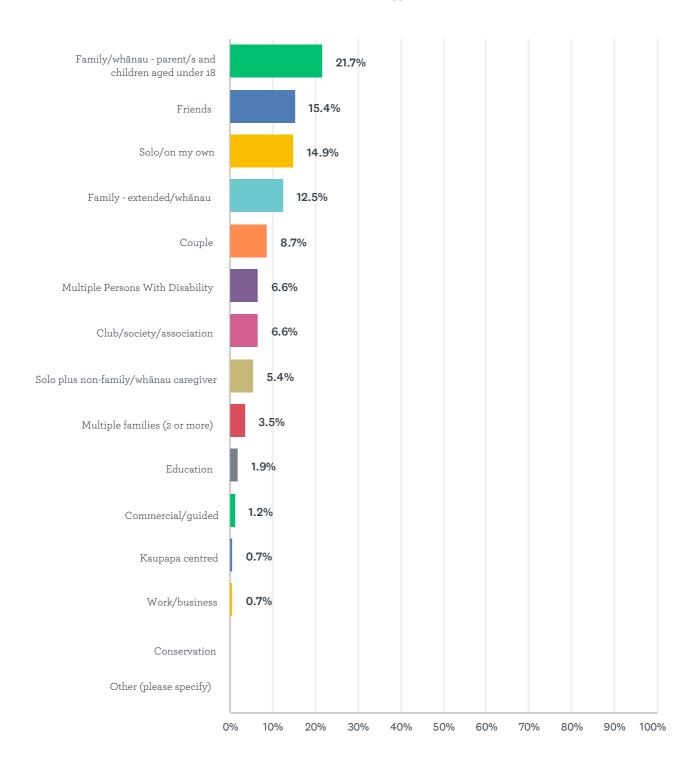






Q29 Which CATEGORY best describes your outdoor recreation PARTY/GROUP?

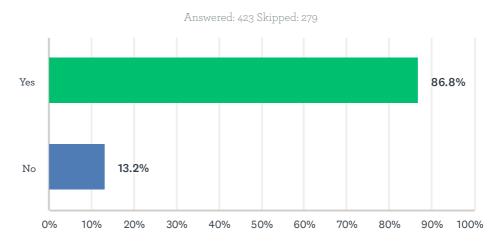

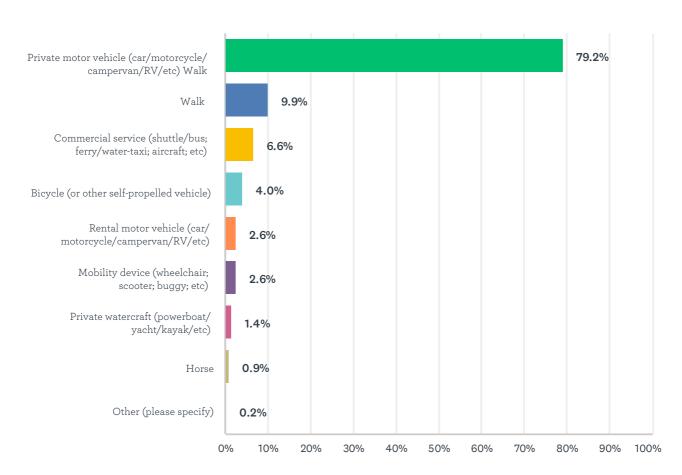

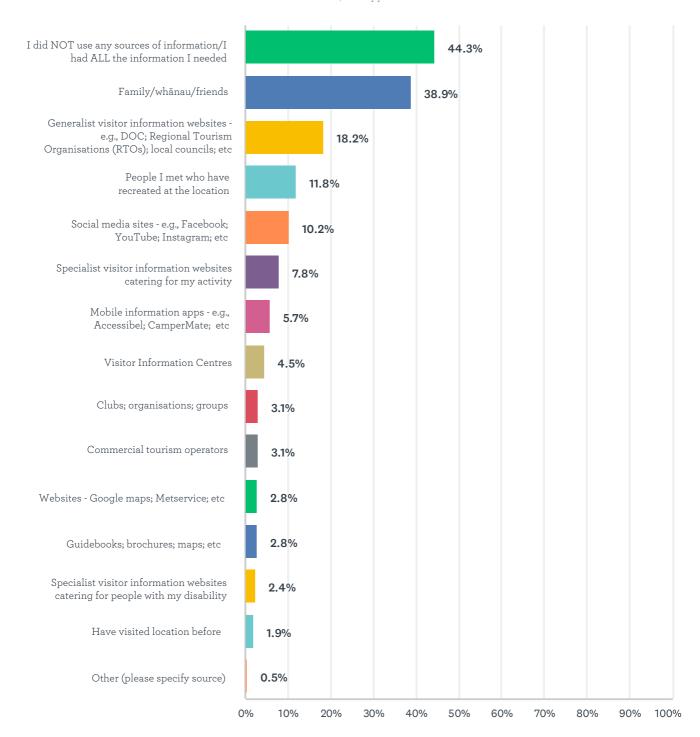






Q32 (Thinking about your most recent outdoor recreation experience) Which of the following SOURCES of information did you USE to support your outdoor recreation experience?

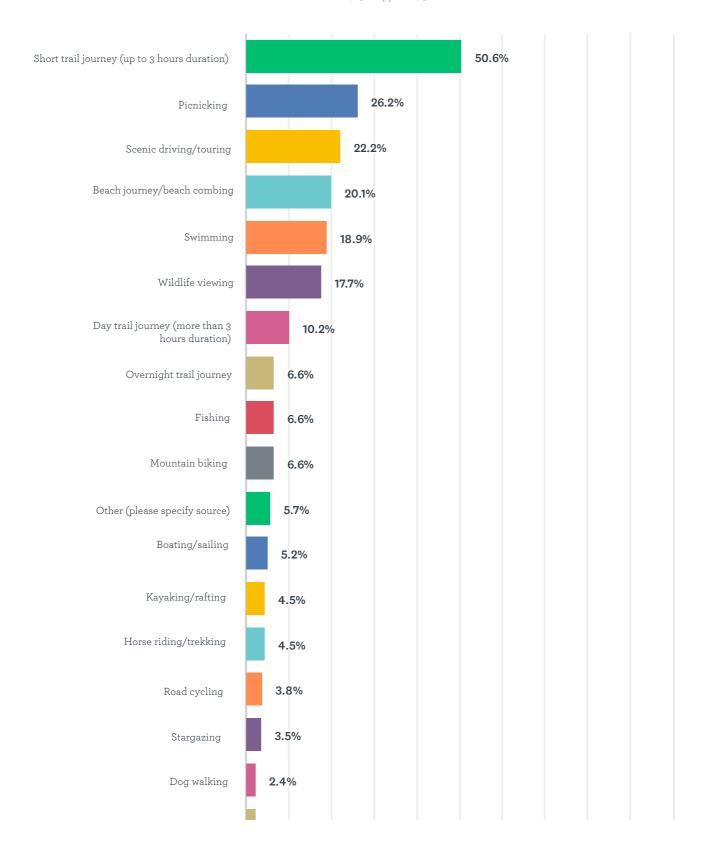
