Providing for Three Additional Commercial Upland Game Preserves

Portfolio Hunting and Fishing

On 2 December 2024, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- noted that commercial upland game preserves have been operating for over 20 years, providing opportunities for hunters and local economic growth;
- 2 **noted** that the New Zealand Fish and Game Council supports the establishment of commercial game preserves as they provide increased hunting opportunities both within such preserves and beyond preserve boundaries;
- agreed that an Order in Council be made under section 8 of the Wildlife Act 1953 to add three new areas, described in Appendix 1 to the paper under CBC-24-SUB-0127, to the list of game preserves listed in Schedule 3 of the Act;
- 4 **invited** the Minister for Hunting and Fishing to issue drafting instructions to the Parliamentary Counsel Office for an Order in Council to give effect to the intention in paragraph 3 above, with the Order in Council to take effect as soon as practicable.
