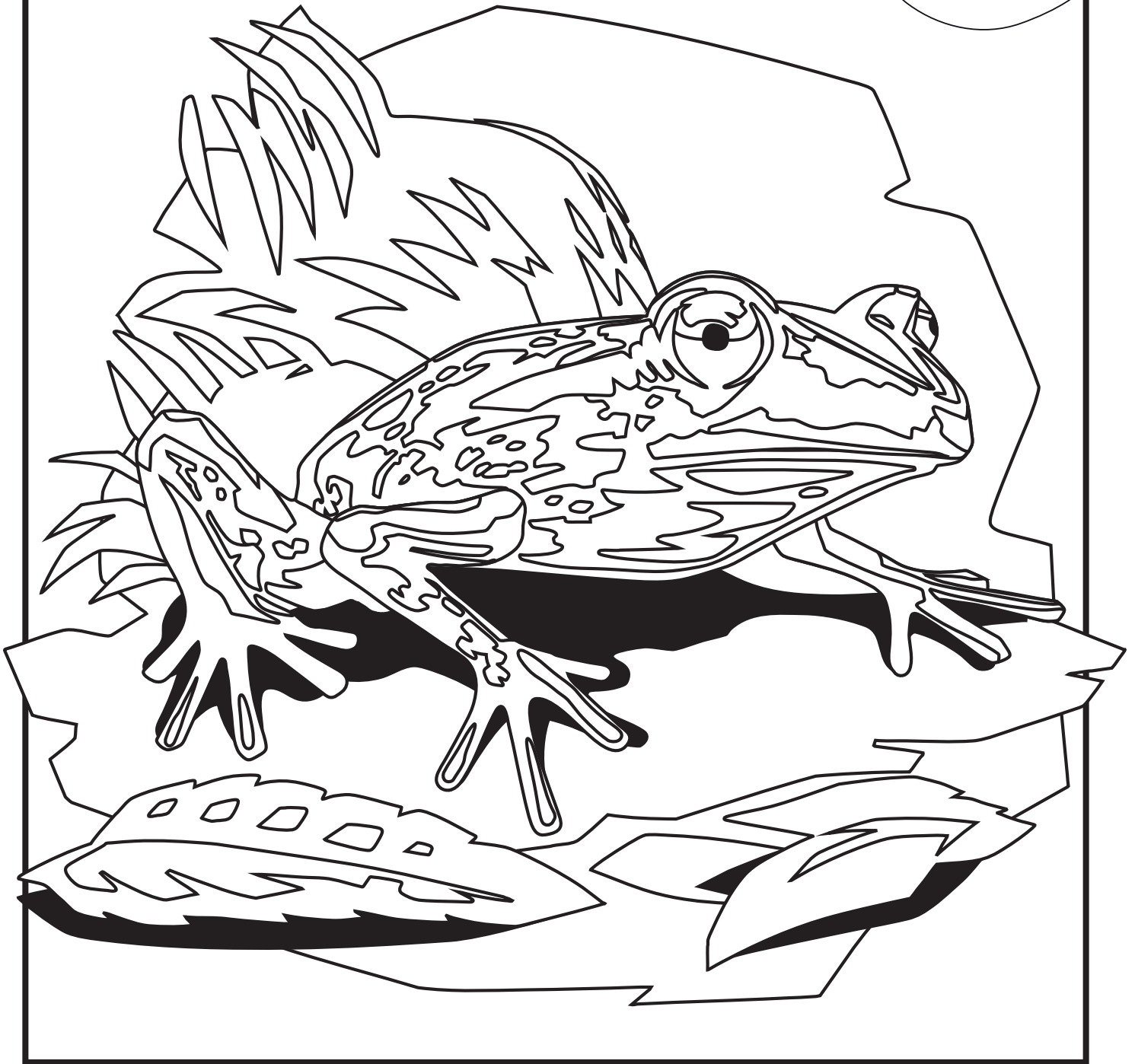

New Zealand's geckos don't lay eggs and usually give birth to twins.

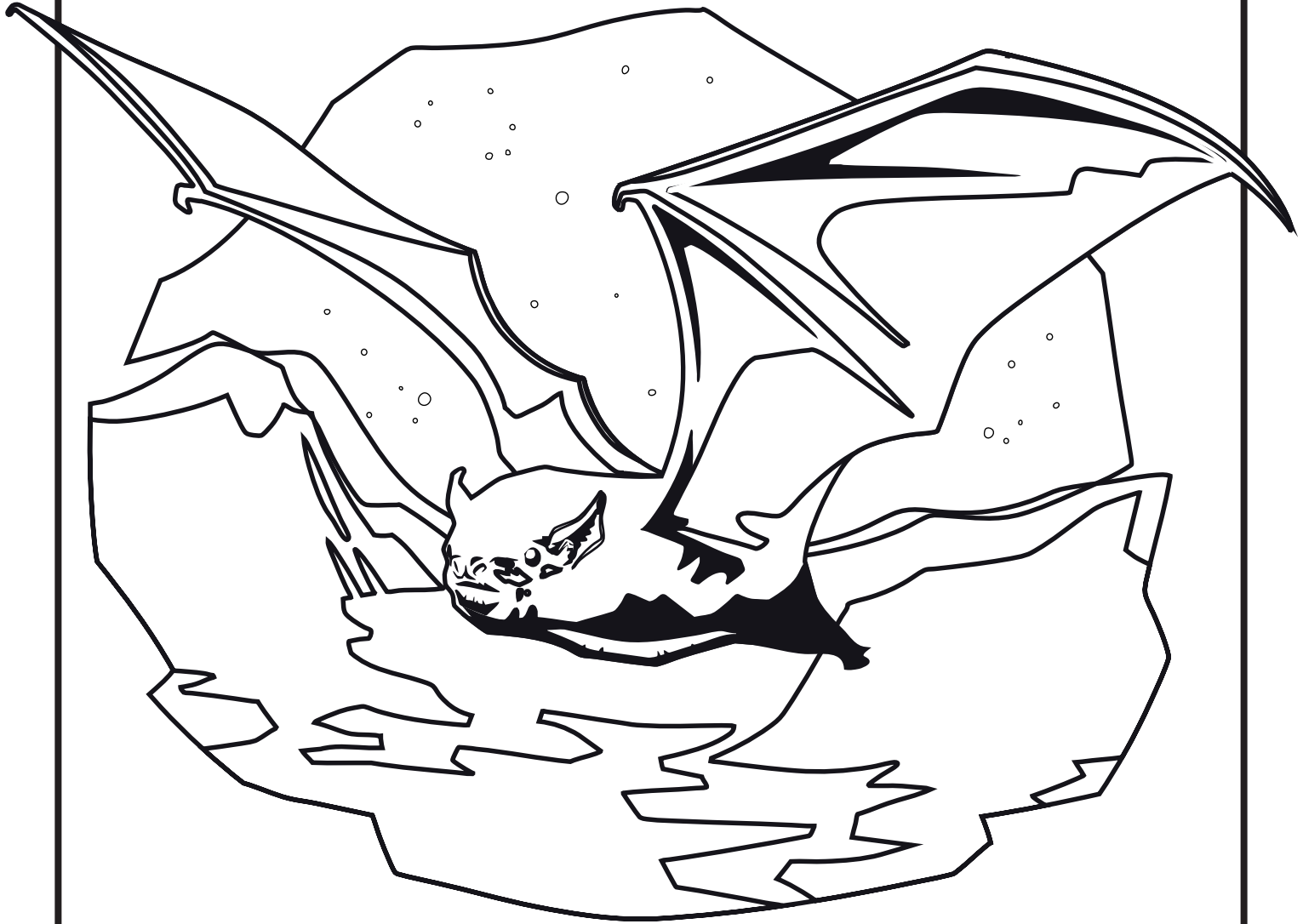

Pekapeka / long-tailed bats have tiny bodies about the size of your thumb but a wingspan nearly as big as a ruler.

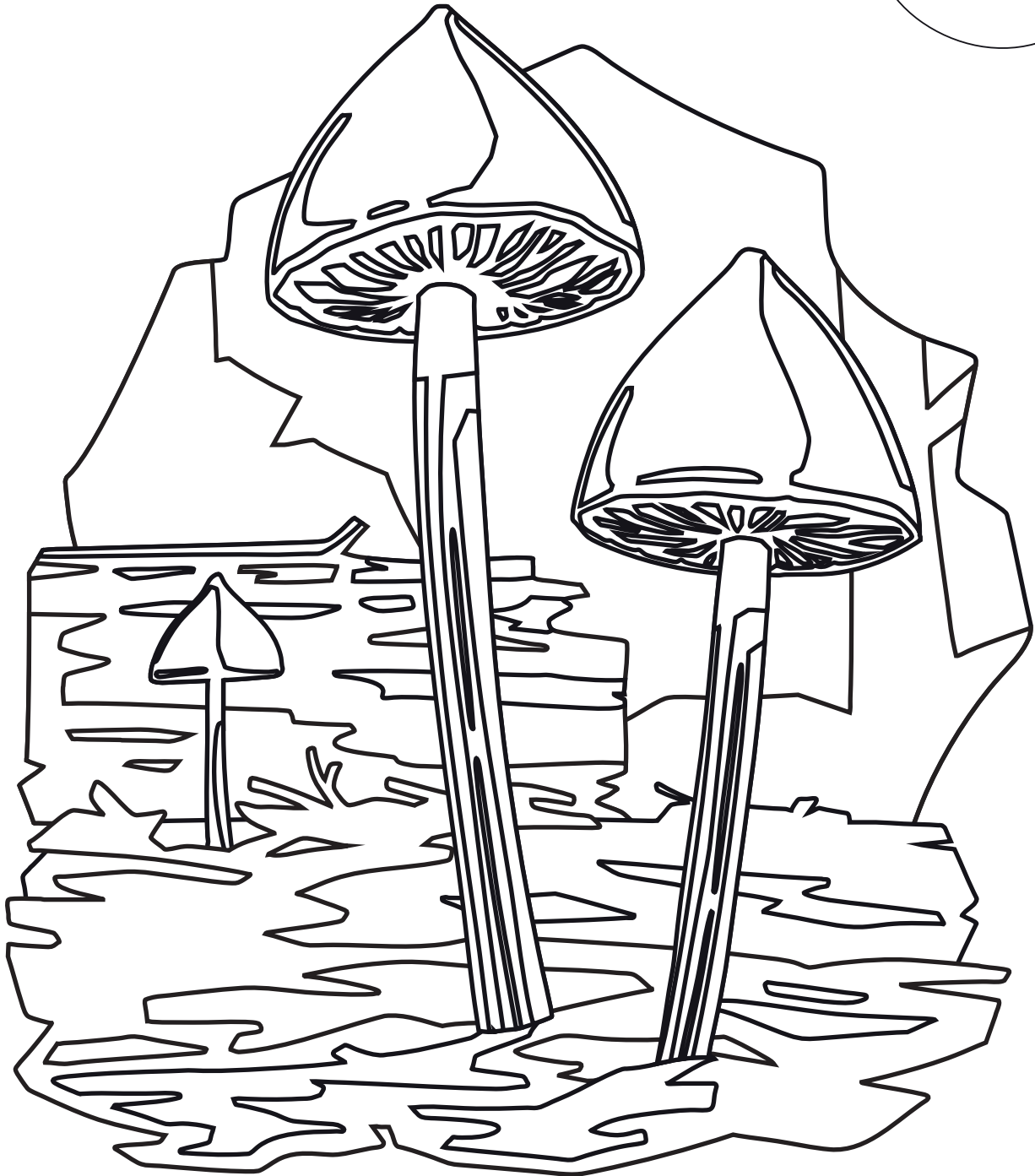
