Context:

There is a project being lead by iwi to replace the North Egmont Visitor Centre (NEVC). Iwi and MBIE will fund a new visitor centre near the existing NEVC. Iwi are starting the planning processes required.

Purpose: To confirm the land status (PCL or other) that the existing parcel of land the NEVC is built on.

Quality and Quantity: An email confirmation of the status of the land and any other matters that may be pertinent to building on this title of land, based on it's legal status (are there an covenants, easements or encumbrances etc that may be relevant).

Summary

- The NEVC is built on the parcel legally described as Part Section 2 Block XIV Egmont Survey District, being an area of 0.9449 hectares
- It is administered by the Department of Conservation and is within part of the Egmont National Park, held under the National Parks Act 1980
- There are no known or found covenants, easements or encumbrances against the parcel of land that the NEVC is built on.

The parcel of land that the North Egmont Visitor Centre (NEVC) is situated is legally named Part Section 2, Block XIV, Egmont Survey District. This parcel is one of many parcels that make up the entire 34,171.1949 hectares area of the Egmont National Park, administered by DOC under Section 4 of the National Parks Act 1980.

History:

Part Section 2 Block XIV Egmont Survey District is only a small parcel of the land that was initially included in first schedule of the Egmont National Park Act 1924, as "containing by admeasurement 72,382 acres more or less, being the land comprised within a circle having a radius of six miles and a centre on the summit of Mount Egmont."

On 25th October 1928, a survey office plan SO 6743 was approved for an area was defined as <u>Section 1 Block X Egmont Survey District</u>. This area on the plan depicts the original position of the "Hostel".

With the introduction of the National Parks Act 1952; the Egmont National Park was re-defined as including all land in Blocks V, VI, VII, IX, X, XIII, XIV, XV Egmont Survey Districts, being the land in a circle having a radius of 6 miles with the centre on the summit of Mt. Egmont and including all internal rivers, lakes, and streams, except for the access roads to the North Egmont Hostel, the Stratford Mountain House and the Dawson Falls Hostel.

The area for the hostel was expanded in 1959 with a new defined parcel deposited on SO Plan 8977. This new area was part of Section 1 Blk X Egmont SD and part Crown Land Block XIV and became legally described as <u>Section 1 Block XIV Egmont Survey District</u>.

On SO 9496, part of Section 1 Block XIV Egmont SD (0 acres, 2 perches, 07.3perches) was excluded from the hostel area. The remaining portion of hostel land area then became described as <u>Section 2 Block XIV</u> Egmont SD.

As per the definition recorded on SO 9583 in 1965; part of Section 2 Block XIV Egmont SD was taken for road and published in the NZ Gazette 1965, page 1011. The remaining balance area is now <u>Part Section 2 Block XIV Egmont SD</u>, which is the current location of the North Egmont Visitor Centre.
