Hi Peter, Thunes
I need your help.
I've cobbled together a request for some DoC funding to build an off-road trail from Sunshine Bay to Seven Mile, which will link downtown Queenstown to the Seven Mile/12 Mile and Moke Lake Bike Trails. Getting cyclists and pedestrians off road will bring a significant improvement in safety, as sharing the Glenorchy Road is becoming increasingly dangerous.
If we are successful with our application, the trail will be formed and a new suspension bridge (approx. 40m) built across the Five Mile Creek below Bleakley's Bridge.
We have an agreement in place with QMTBC that they will take on the maintenance of the trail, but we need QLDC's support in taking on the bridge as an asset for maintenance.
Its pretty critical to get this across the line asap if our funding is to be successful and I hope you can see the benefits which would result.
