






Coastal shrub community




The coastal shrubs along the western side of Matiu/Somes provide homes for much of the island's wildlife. Many insects, skinks, geckos, tuatara and birds will all be sheltering in this area. Look for animals using the coastal shrub community as their home. Little blue penguins often nest in the flax bushes. While you are on the island they will be out at sea feeding and won't be home until dark.

-  **Find a place along the track to sit quietly and look and listen for animals.**
-  **Use your optic explorers to take a closer look at animals that use these coastal plants for shelter.**
-  **Look for signs that tell you that penguins live here**
