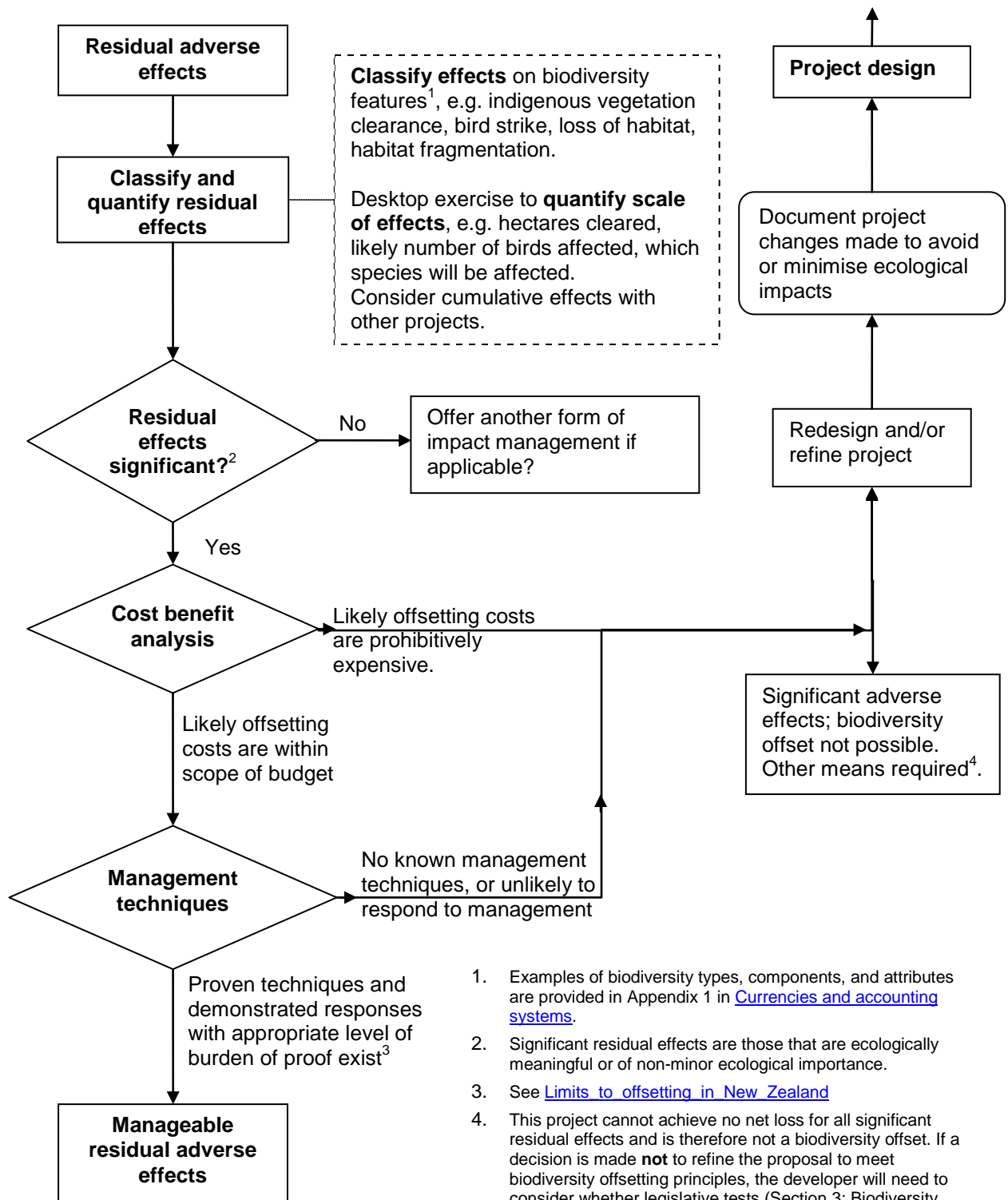


Options to address residual adverse effects

2. Significant residual effects are those that are ecologically meaningful or of non-minor ecological importance.

If a decision is made **not** to refine the proposal to meet biodiversity offsetting principles, the developer will need to consider whether legislative tests (Section 3: Biodiversity offsetting within the New Zealand legislative framework) can be met through applying other forms of impact management.
