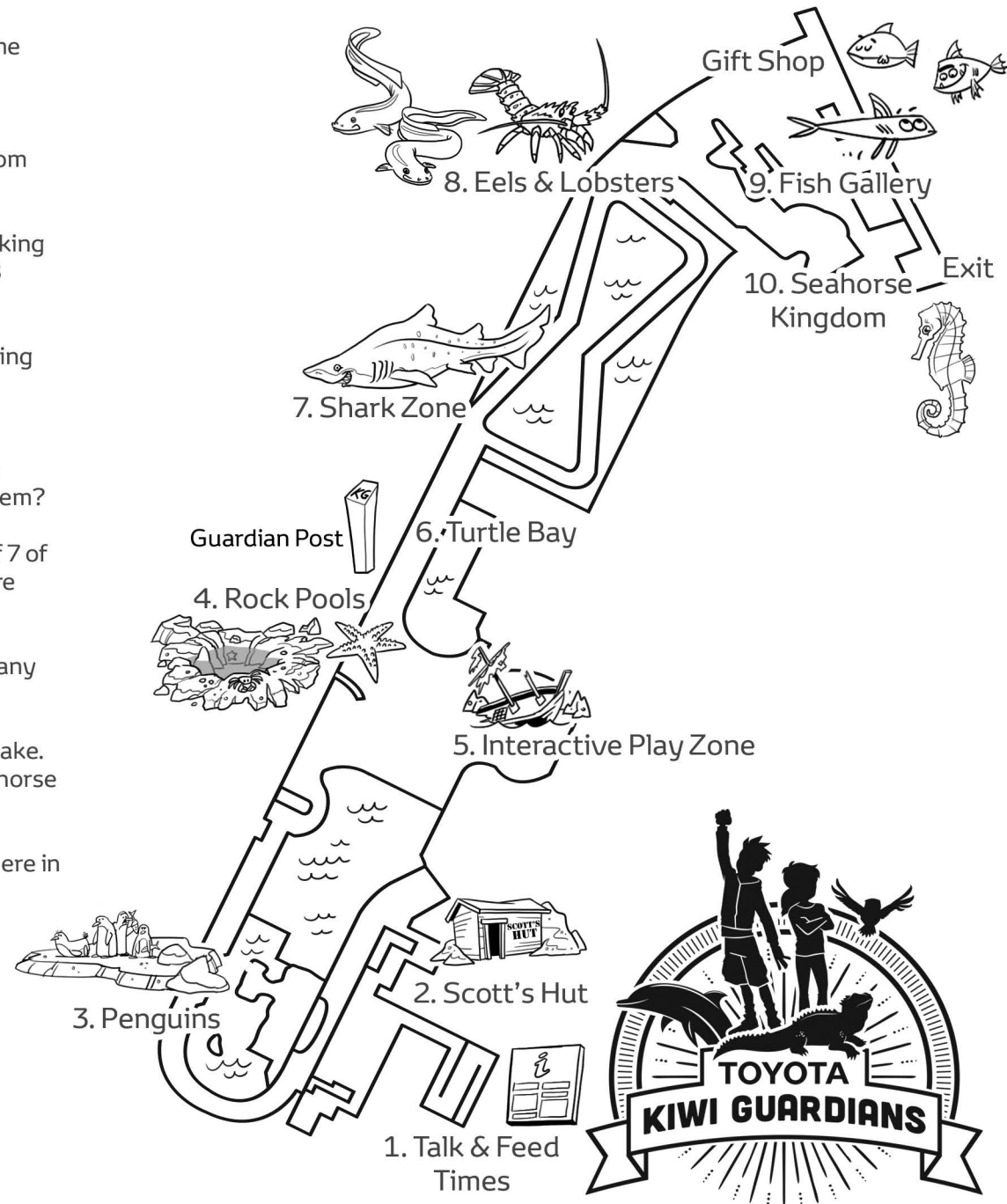


SEA LIFE KELLY TARLTON'S AUCKLAND - THE UNDERWATER WORLD!

1. **Talk & Feed Times:** Want to see a shark feed in real life? Check to see what time the animal feeds and talks are.
2. **Scott's Hut:** Step back in time to see what life was like for Antarctic explorer Captain Scott. Could you eat Hoosh? This Antarctic explorer stew is made from half beef, half fat and water!!!
3. **Penguins:** Become an Antarctic penguin spotter. Can you tell which ones are king penguins and which ones are gentoo? Did you know that 13 of the world's 18 penguin species come to Aotearoa New Zealand's waters?
4. **Rock Pools:** Can you believe there are more than 15,000 different kinds of living things in Aotearoa New Zealand's oceans? Time to get your hands wet and explore in the rock pools! What can you find?
5. **Interactive Play Zone:** Have fun and start playing in the Amazing Creations & Shipwreck Shores area. Nemo & Dory are hiding somewhere, can you spot them?
6. **Turtle Bay:** Turtles, turtles, everywhere! We are lucky enough to have 5 out of 7 of the worlds honu / sea turtle species visit our oceans! But did you know they're under threat? How can you help protect them?
7. **Shark Zone:** Da dum... Da dum... Da dum... Watch out, mangō / shark! How many can you see? The Wobbegong shark may be quite tricky to spot though!
8. **Eels and Lobsters:** Look at the tuna /eel slithering through the water like a snake. Did you know some long-finned eels weigh up to 50kgs and kōura / the Packhorse Lobster is the largest type in the world! That's heavy stuff.
9. **Fish Gallery:** Can you find Rocky the sneaky octopus /wheke hidden somewhere in the gallery? Do you know it has nine brains and three hearts!
10. **Seahorse Kingdom:** A fiery creature is hiding somewhere. Can you spot the kiore moana / spiny sea dragon? They can reach depths of over 300 meters!
