

**Summary of Abel Tasman Foreshore Scenic Reserve Management Plan
Provisions for Water-based Commercially Guided Trips Activity**

<p>Can start or finish a trip (no time restrictions), except at: Medlands Bay; or the western Anchorage Coastal Access Point (unless toilets are built at this location).</p> <p>Can carry out briefings, games, training and induction of groups.</p> <p>Can carry out passive activities such as interpretation and meal breaks.</p> <p>No more than two groups (up to 20 people, including guides) from the same company to be together at the same time and location.</p>	<p>Can land between 9am and 12pm (midday) only (see exception below).</p> <p>Can carry out passive activities such as interpretation and meal breaks.</p> <p>No starting or finishing of trips, and no briefings, games, training or induction of groups (see exception below).</p> <p>No more than two groups (up to 20 people, including guides) from the same company to be together at the same time and location.</p> <p>Exception – any local landowner who has a resource consent for an associated commercial activity on private land at Torrent Bay may land and may start/finish etc at any time.</p>	<p>Can carry out passive activities such as interpretation and meal breaks.</p> <p>No starting or finishing a trip, and no briefings, games, pre-departure training or induction of groups, except where the activity is carried out by a local landowner who has a resource consent for an associated commercial activity on private land at Awaroa.</p> <p>No entry into vessel exclusion zone at Venture Creek, Awaroa, from the first weekend prior to Christmas until the first Monday after Waitangi Day.</p> <p>No more than two groups (up to 20 people, including guides) from the same company to be together at the same time and location.</p>	<p>Can carry out passive activities such as interpretation and meal breaks.</p> <p>No starting or finishing a trip, except at Observation Beach bays.</p> <p>No games or induction of groups (briefings and pre-departure training may take place at Observation Beach bays for guided parties who have walked, or been transported by water taxi, to this location and will depart via non-motorised watercraft).</p> <p>No landing on any island, except Adele Island/Motuareronui.</p> <p>No landing at locations where there are no public toilets available unless the operator has portable toilet facilities for all clients.</p> <p>No more than two groups (up to 20 people, including guides) from the same company to be together at the same time and location.</p>	<p>No landings</p>
