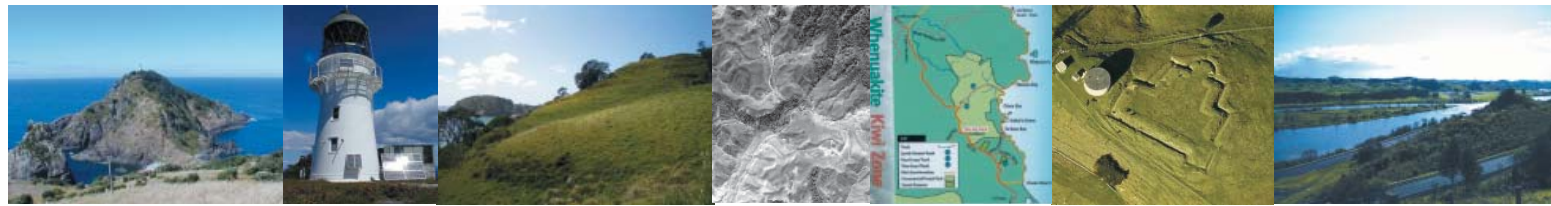

- = **Permit:** A DOC permit is required before visiting this site
- = **Icon site:** A site that tells an important story of New Zealand identity and provides an outstanding visitor experience
